## **ROSTER & ELIGIBILITY:**

We will use your WPA "District" roster form for the Bonney Lake site program. Your WCD/SWD "District" Volleyball Roster should be completed and posted on your WPA Volleyball Roster page no later than **Friday, November 15<sup>th</sup> by 1 pm**. We will pull the rosters off your site. Please note, a team photo is part of the "District" roster page.

## **TEAM ENTRANCE:**

All players, coaches, and managers/trainers must enter the building through the Pass Gate which is located on the front of the gym – near the main entrance.

## **TEAM ENTRY:**

Each team will be allowed a roster of 14 players and 6 coaches/managers/statisticians (7 if you have a trainer/doctor). **These numbers are the same as the State Tournament. Only those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench.** All players and coaches/managers should enter together through the pass gate.

## **PASSES:**

Only WCD Executive Board, SWD Executive Board, WCD Sponsor, WSCA & WSSAAA passes will be accepted. ***Any other passes including League or Season Passes WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED***

## **PASS GATE & PASS LIST:**

The pass gate will be next to the main ticket entrance. Administrators and Faculty who are on the pass list must be in the area your students/fans are sitting in during matches. Your assistance is valuable and important in maintaining a positive sportsmanship like atmosphere at the tournament. Spectators wishing to leave and return for a later match will be stamped.

## **TEAM INTRODUCTIONS:**

Due to the tournament format (two games being played simultaneously) there will not be player introductions or announcing.

## **OFFICIALS & SCORERS:**

The Tournament director will arrange for officials from officiating boards located in District III & IV. **These officials will serve as game officials and line persons.** Assigning secretaries from each board represented determine all official assignments.

**If your team uses a Libero, then you must provide a libero tracker at the scorer's table. If both teams use a Libero, the home team will be responsible for providing the tracker at the scorer's table.** The WCD will **not** supply a libero tracker. Although the scoreboards will be operated by tournament staff, they will not be the official score of the match. The tournament directors have arranged for official score keepers to be at the scorer's table for each match. They will have the official score.

## **GAME BALLS:**

**Game balls will be arranged by the tournament committee. All game balls will be WCD approved Baden volleyballs.**

## **COURT ASSIGNMENTS:**

Drawn by West Central District Volleyball Committee. The Tournament Directors shall have the authority to make adjustments as necessary.

### **TRAINING ROOM:**

The Bonney Lake HS training room will be open to provide ice for teams when requested. The training room is located in the hall next to the main gym. There will be one certified athletic trainer, provided by ATI, to serve team and athlete needs.

### **LOCKER ROOMS:**

Locker rooms will be available upon request. Teams should not leave gear or valuables unattended in the locker rooms. They will not be locked and multiple teams will have access to them throughout the two days.

### **CHEERLEADERS:**

Cheerleaders will be admitted through the pass gate only and must be in uniform. During matches officials and/or the Tournament Director will determine what areas are suitable for cheer squads. For the safety of everyone involved cheer squads must stay in the designated areas.

### **FILMING:**

There are limited power outlets at each court. Bring extra batteries. Filming must take place in the stands since the floor is a playable area.

### **TEAM BUSES & TEAM VANS:**

We ask that all team buses drop athletes off in front of the gym (next to the Performing Arts Center ) AND park in the upper lot off of 199<sup>th</sup> next to the baseball field. The teams will enter through the main spectator entrance of the gymnasium.

### **SPECTATOR PARKING:**

Spectator parking is located at the lower lot next to the stadium off 104<sup>th</sup> or directly in front of the gym. Overflow parking is available in the upper parking lot near the tennis courts and baseball field.

### **SPECTATOR SEATING:**

Main gym spectator seating will be in the large bleachers. The small bleachers behind the scorer's table will be for team members, officials and event workers only. Upper gym spectators will be in the chairs that are opposite the team benches and scorer's table. No spectators allowed on the team bench side of either court. Spectators are not allowed on the playing surface at any time. All video-taping must also be done from either the stands or the designated filming areas upstairs adjacent to the stands.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

1. Bands are not permitted at this event.
2. Only an official school banner (made of cloth or vinyl) will be permitted.
3. Artificial noisemakers of any kind are not permitted and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors or tournament staff.
4. Throwing confetti or other materials is not permitted.

The use of tobacco, vaping devices or tobacco products on Sumner-Bonney Lake School District property (including parking lots) is prohibited.

### **CONCESSIONS:**

The concession stand in the gym foyer will be open during most of the tournaments hours. There will be a hospitality room for coaches and officials ONLY. It will consist of water and snacks.

### **PRE MATCH WARM-UP:**

*The WIAA state tournament format will be used. We will start with 8 minutes of shared court time, followed by 6 minutes for the home team, then 6 minutes for the visiting team. Hitting or serving the ball into the opponent's court is not allowed during the shared court time. Teams are not allowed to warm-up on the sidelines or endlines while waiting for their court time.*

### **TOURNAMENT RULES:**

2019 National Federation rules will be used with the following exceptions:

1. Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 sets. The first four sets to 25 and the fifth set to 15 with no cap. A team must win by 2 points.
2. Each team must furnish their own warm-up balls. Match balls will be furnished by the tournament manager.
3. All game officials and line judges will be furnished by the Officials Association.

### **DESIGNATION OF HOME TEAM:**

1. The home team will be the bottom team on each bracket.
2. The home team warms up first.

### **GAMES COMMITTEE:**

Will consist of: Tournament Manager, Head Official and an athletic director.

### **DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO BONNEY LAKE HIGH SCHOOL**

- **From HWY 167 (North or Southbound)**
  - **Take the Highway 410, Sumner/Yakima exit eastbound**
  - **Follow Hwy 410 up the hill into Bonney Lake**
  - **At the fifth (5<sup>th</sup>) traffic light on Hwy 410, turn right onto South Prairie Road**
  - **At the first traffic light on South Prairie, turn right onto 199<sup>th</sup>**
  - **Spectator Parking and Athlete drop off –**
    - **At the first traffic light on 199<sup>th</sup>, turn right onto 104<sup>th</sup>**
    - **School is just past the Maintenance/Transportation Center on the left**
    - **Fan parking entry – first driveway past the reader board on the left**
    - **Athlete drop off – second driveway past the reader board on the left. Bus parking should be in the upper lot. Do not park buses in front of the gym.**
