- * Games played at Everett Memorial Stadium on Funko Field, admission will be charged for all of these games.
- * Seeding to state: Winner of game 9 will be the first seed, with the loser of game 9 second seed. Third and Fourth place game will not be played as both teams qualify for state.

* <u>Rainout Procedure:</u>

If any of the games 1-12 are rained out on a particular day, all games that day will be postponed and rescheduled to the next available day. In case of a rainout for a 4:00 p.m. game, schools will be called by 1:30 p.m.

If a game is interrupted prior to the 5th inning <u>or</u> after the 5th inning and the score tied after the last complete inning, the game shall be suspended and resumed at the point of interruption on the next available day. The line-up and batting order of each team shall be exactly the same as the line-up and batting order at the moment of suspension, subject to the rules governing the game. If a game is interrupted after the 5th inning and the score is not tied after the last complete inning, the game shall be called official and the winner declared according to the score at the end of the last complete inning.

IV. OFFICIALS / UMPIRES

- A. Officials for play-in games and games played at the higher seed will be the responsibility of the home school.
- B. The reservation of tournament umpires (Games 5,6 and Games 9, 12) shall be the responsibility of the NW District One Director.

V. TICKET INFORMATION

- A. Tickets will be sold via Go FAN only. Gates will be open one hour prior to the first scheduled game.
- B. **Exception of ticket sales:** There will not be a charge for games played at the higher seed sites. Ticket sales will take place for games 5 and 6 and games 9 and 12 at Everett Memorial Stadium.
- C. Prices will be as follows:

VI. PASSES

- A. <u>Acceptable Passes:</u> District one Event supervisor pass, Administrator's pass, District one Lifetime pass, Northwest League Lifetime pass, WSCA membership (with photo ID), WSSAAA membership card .
- B. Each school will be allowed a MAXIMUM OF 29 People on the pass list for admittance into the stadium. This number is to include: managers, bus driver, scorekeeper, faculty representative, coaches and players. This list should be submitted to Wescoathletics.com by the Thursday before the first round. Any last minute changes can be phoned in, or emailed no later than 3 PM, Friday, before the first round to the Everett SD Athletic Office (425) 385-4260. No changes will be permitted after first game.

VII. <u>ROSTERS/PROGRAM INFORMATION</u>

- A. Team eligibility will be in accordance with the State guidelines.
- B. Roster changes may be made between each day of the tournament.
- C. Rosters and team personnel will be pulled from Wescoathletics.com the Thursday before the first round. **Supervisors are encouraged to use the District One colored-back pass, WSSAAA membership card or WSCA membership card for admission**. Notify the host site as to whom will supervise the game. Any last minute changes can be phoned in to the Everett SD Athletic office, or emailed no later than <u>3PM, Friday before the first round</u>.

VIII. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- A. The tournament director will collect starting lineups 45 minutes before game time. Teams will exchange line-ups at this time.
- B. Dressing facilities will <u>NOT</u> be available. <u>Teams are to come dressed and ready to play.</u>
- C. Towels will <u>NOT</u> be provided.
- D. Each team will be allowed 10 minutes of infield/outfield warm up, starting with the home team.
- E. The home team will be the team with the higher seed.
- F. The home team will use the third base dugout.
- G. Only uniformed players will be allowed on the team bench.

- H. Game length / 10 run rule: All games are seven (7) innings and must be played to completion, except if one team is ahead by ten (10) runs or more after the completion of five (5) innings, in this case the game will be over. Any game ending in a tie after seven (7) innings, will continue until a winner is determined. In case of a game being called after it has begun due to inclement weather, five (5) innings will constitute a regulation game. If the game is suspended due to inclement weather prior to being a regulation game, the game will resume from the point of suspension per WIAA State Tournament Guidelines.
- I. Game balls will be provided by the home team for games at higher seed. Game balls will be provided by the tournament manager for games at Everett Memorial Stadium.
- J. The home team will provide the official scorekeeper in games at higher seed. The tournament committee will provide the official scorekeeper for all games at Everett Memorial.
- K. The WIAA Baseball State Guidelines will be followed.

VIII. AWARDS

A first place District 1 trophy will be awarded at the conclusion of the tournament.

X. PROTESTS

Decisions on protests must be determined at the time of the protest. The tournament committee will act on all tournament protests.

XII. PARKING, ENTRANCE AND TICKET SALES

A. All parking, ticket sales and entrance to the stadium will be at the SOUTH END ONLY (39th and Broadway).

Buses should drop student/athletes off at the SOUTH gate and park in the back of the parking lot.

XIII. CONCESSIONS

A. Concessions will be available at all games held at Everett Memorial Stadium.
