VI. Regional Qualifiers

The top 3 finishers at each weight will qualify for 4A Region I, Wrestling Tournament.

The Fourth place will wrestling a pigtail match vs NPSL 5 at regionals. Fourth and Fifth place finishers will be first and second alternates at Regionals.

- 4. Round 4: Championship and Consolation Finals and Awards—3 Mats (Mat 1: 1st/2nd place; Mat 2: 3rd/4th place; Mat 3: 5th/6th place) (2pm-3pm)

IX. Weigh-Ins

Weigh-ins will be conducted in the aux. gym beginning at 8:30 am on Saturday February 3. Skin, nail and hair checks will begin 15 minutes prior to the start of weigh-ins. Weigh-ins will be conducted by weight and will follow the new weigh-in guidelines. Wrestlers will need to bring picture ID for weigh-ins. Once a weight class has weighed in, weigh ins for that weight class will be closed. Any wrestler not weighed in by the time that weight class weigh-in time closes will be disqualified. Any challenge scales need to be on site and calibrated before weigh-ins begin.

There will not be a doctor on site for weigh-ins. It is each head coach's responsibility to have all required and current documentation for skin checks. Make sure all documentation is current and on authorized forms with ALL required information included.

X. Officials/Disputes

- i. Officials will be assigned from Snohomish County and Skagit County Associations.
- ii. Each host site will have a Tournament Committee that will consist of the Tournament Director, the head official, and a coach, athletic director or school administrator not involved in the dispute in question. Games committee members do not need to be onsite but must be readily available via phone during the tournament.
- iii. If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation or misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the match official and tournament director immediately following the incident in question.
- iv. Tournament director will confer with the tournament committee. The decision of the Tournament Committee is final.
- v. The WIAA Expulsion Rules will be followed.

XI. Event Staffing/Table Help

- i. The host school will provide the scorekeepers to work each Mat table.
- ii. Scoring will logged into Track Wrestling at each mat.
- iii. If score needs to be changed, the head Track Wrestling Representative will be notified.

XII. Athletic Trainers/Medical Staff

There will be an athletic trainer on site. However, teams need to bring their own medical kits fully stocked.

XIII. Admission and Approved Passes

NOTE: For events held at Wesco schools, tickets will be sold at www.gofan.com and at the door with cash or check.

i. Ticket Prices (plus GoFan fees) All students, host and visiting, must pay admission.

ii. Pass list.

- iv. Cheer squads of participating schools will be admitted in full uniform, with advisor.

XIV. Awards

- i. Medals will be awarded to the first-place finishers in each weight class. Ribbons will be awarded for additional placers, per league policy.
- ii. Individual awards will be presented during the championship session.

XV. Programs/Tee-shirts

We are working on securing a vendor for sweatshirts and tees for the tournament.

XVI. Additional Information:

- Concession Stand will be on site.
- No outside food is allowed on site. For Wrestlers, they can bring in what they need to eat pre-tournament.
- Gym Floor around the mats is reserved for players, coaches, match officials, and tournament personal.
- Spectators need to be seated in bleachers.
- School supervisors of participating schools should check in with the site manager. School supervisors are responsible in helping maintain good sportsmanship and behavior of their fans.
- Locker rooms will be available for team use. Locker rooms will not have supervision and items should not be left in the locker room. Host sites are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- If needed, overflow parking is available next door at Heatherwood Middle School.
