TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

Friday, February 13, 2026 – 1 MATS

- 3:00 PM – Weigh-in at Community Center team restrooms – all teams must be present at the beginning of the weigh-in process.
- 3:00 PM – Doors open for ticket sales
- 3:30 PM - Concession stand (**will stay open until last match of day or they sell out**)
- 3:45 PM – Final Coaches / officials’ meeting in the Hospitality Room
- 5:00 PM – First call for on-deck wrestlers / Pledge of Allegiance
- 5:10 PM – Wrestling begins

All sessions will be run back-to-back until championship matches are completed.

TOURNAMENT POINTS

The top two (2) placers in each weight class earn points.

1st place is seeded at regionals 2nd place wrestles pig tail at regionals

WEIGH-IN

- a. National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used at all WIAA Regional Tournaments.
- b. Electronic scales will be used for weigh-ins and should expedite the process.
- c. Officials will be available at the weigh-ins for skin checks. Officials will be at each scale. We will run at least one scale but are going to try to have 2 available

SPECIAL NOTE

Wrestlers with open sores, ringworm, or a contagious situation must have a signed doctor's release printed on the doctor's letterhead stationery, which include a statement "no longer contagious" and contains what was being treated and how it was treated. A doctor's release is required for each mark or blemish printed on doctor's letterhead "stationery" — at the regional tournament, the referees will only accept open sores forms on the "updated NFHS skin form from the WIAA website"

WARM-UPS

The mats will be available for the wrestlers from 2:45pm until 3:30pm to warm up.

ADMISSION PRICES

\$9.00 – Adults and Students w/out ASB

\$6.00 – Students (7-12) with ASB cards

\$6.00 – Senior Citizens (65+)

\$6.00 – Students K-6 (must be accompanied by adult)

FREE – Preschool and younger when accompanied by an adult

Ticket Sales will start 45 minutes prior to first matches.

Students without ASB cards will be charged adult price.

PASSES

1. Only Northwest District One Event Supervisory passes, Northwest District Lifetime passes and WIAA passes will be accepted.
2. Each participating school will be allowed to place the following individuals on a pass list: participating athletes, coaches, administrative supervisors, one manager, one trainer, one school reporter, one school photographer and Cheerleaders in uniform and their advisor.

MISCELLANEOUS

1. A hospitality room, sponsored by the Darrington Wrestling Boosters Club, will be open to coaches and officials only. The hospitality room will be located in the Community Center Kitchen.
2. Buses: there is ample room for buses to park near the gym. Please do not park in front of the gym in the fire lane area.
3. Concessions stand, including breakfast and lunch, will be located in the Community Center kitchen.

AWARDS

Individual 1st – 2nd place at each weight will receive a medal, Team trophy will be awarded.

All Wrestlers must be entered on Track wrestling more information to follow

LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be provided. Individuals will need to provide their own towels and are expected to treat the facilities with care. PLEASE do not leave valuables in the locker rooms.

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.

- a) The **south bleachers** are assigned to the schools Darrington, Muckleshoot and their fans.
- b) The **north bleachers** are assigned from the schools Concrete, Friday Harbor and their fans.
- c) Only two coaches and a scorer per school at a mat. Wrestlers not wrestling may not sit in the coach’s area. Passes will be issued to coaches and scorekeepers.
- d) Photographers and video Cameras – ***Will NOT be allowed on the mats. Please inform parents that they will not be allowed to photograph in the wrestling area.***

PROTESTS

Any dispute occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Director who will confer with the Tournament Committee. The committee decision will be final. If a dispute involves a wrestler from the school of a committee member, this member will disqualify himself/herself.

CONCESSIONS

There will be concessions available until the end of the tournament.

W.I.A.A. TOURNAMENT RULES

WIAA tournament rules will apply. (i.e. Sportsmanship, signs, noisemakers, floor restrictions, coaches in the corner and admissions.)

INJURED WRESTLERS

A wrestler removed from participation in a tournament match due to an injury, shall not be allowed to continue until authorized by the medical authority that made the original decision at that tournament, or his/her designee. Decisions by the medical authority are final.

W.I.A.A. EJECTION RULE

Wrestlers barred from all further competition (remainder of Regionals and State Tournament) if:

- 1. EJECTED FOR FIRST instance of Flagrant Misconduct (Federation Rule) OR
- 2. EJECTED FOR SECOND instance of Un-sportsmanlike Conduct (Federation Rule) of an “Abusive” nature (W.I.A.A. standard).

USE OF TOBACCO
