ADMISSION

PASSES

- District 1 Pass only and District 1 Lifetime passes are valid for admission.
- The school name must be printed/typed on the pass.
- No other passes will be accepted.
- Participants, coaches, and support staff must be submitted on the pass list provided below.
- This list needs to be completed and returned to the Stanwood HS Athletic Office by **noon on Wednesday, February 4.**

TOURNAMENT SEEDING: * *To ensure accurate seeding, please verify all rosters and matches are entered and finalized in OPC.*

- **Seeding Entries:** Submit names into TrackWrestling no later than noon on Tuesday, February 3rd.
- **Seeding Criteria:** Based on State Placer, State Participant, Head-to-Head Match, Total Wins, and Win Percentage.

SESSION SCHEDULE

- **Weigh-ins & Skin Checks** : 7:00 am in the Main Gym (Athletes must bring photo ID).
- **Coaches Meeting**: 8:30 am in the Hospitality Room.
- **Matches Begin**: 9:00 am.
- **Format**: We will utilize 4 mats and wrestle straight through the finals.

WEIGH-IN PROCEDURES

- National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used.
- Wrestlers receive standard **2 lb growth allowance**.
- Officials will be available for skin checks; we will run at least three scales.
- Only coaches are permitted in the weigh-in area until the process is complete.

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS & SPORTSMANSHIP: *WIAA Tournament Rules Apply*

- **Spectators**: Not allowed in the wrestling areas.
- **Mat Side**: Limited to two coaches and one scorer per school.
- **Media**: Only official photographers are allowed on the floor.
- **Conduct**: Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their wrestlers and parents.
- **Noise**: No bands or artificial noisemakers are allowed.

LOCKER ROOMS

- Locker rooms, though unsecured, will be provided for athletes.
- Individuals must provide their own towels and are expected to treat the facilities with care.
- Stanwood School District will not assume responsibility for lost or stolen items.

HOSPITALITY ROOM

- A hospitality room will be available for event workers, participating coaches, and officials.

TRAINERS / FIRST AID

- Stanwood High School will provide an Athletic Trainer.
- Visiting schools are welcome to send their own trainers.
- Please have your teams bring medical kits stocked with tape.
- Decisions made by the on-site medical authority regarding injured wrestlers are final.

DISPUTES & PROTESTS

- Protests must be filed by a school representative (coach or administrator) and presented to the Tournament Director.
- The Tournament Director will confer with the Tournament Games Committee to reach a decision.
- Decisions made by the Games Committee are final and may not be appealed.
- Parents or other non-school persons are not permitted to file or be involved in a protest.

AWARDS & STATE QUALIFYING

- **Awards**: Individual 1st place at each weight receives a District 1 medal; all state qualifiers receive a ribbon.

- **Qualifiers:** The top 9 finishers in each weight class qualify for the WIAA State Tournament at the Tacoma Dome.

CONCESSIONS

SHS Booster Club is planning to offer a full concession stand on Saturday, February 7th, pending volunteer availability.

PARKING

Buses will be asked to park in the bus stalls on the South side of the school. Participating teams can enter through the lower level. All other spectators enter through the athletic entrance on the North side of the building.
