SEED MEETING

Seed Meeting **February 4th at 6pm** on Zoom directly following the WESCO post season meeting. Coaches will need to enter all information for wrestlers into track wrestling. Including weight class, record and grade.

WEIGH-INS

Weigh-ins will be conducted in the aux. gym beginning at 8:00am on Saturday February 7. Skin, nail and hair checks will begin 15 minutes prior to the start of weigh-ins. Weigh-ins will be conducted by weight and will follow the new weigh-in guidelines. Wrestlers will need to bring picture ID for weigh-ins. Once a weight class has weighed in, weigh ins for that weight class will be closed. Any wrestler not weighed in by the time that weight class weigh-in time closes will be disqualified. Any challenge scales need to be on site and calibrated before weigh-ins begin.

There will not be a doctor on site for weigh-ins. It is each head coach's responsibility to have all required and current documentation for skin checks. Make sure all documentation is current and on authorized forms with ALL required information included.

OFFICIALS/DISPUTES

- Officials will be assigned from Snohomish County and Skagit County Associations.
- Host site will have a Tournament Committee that will consist of the Tournament Director, the head official, and a coach, athletic director or school administrator not involved in the dispute in question. Games committee members do not need to be onsite but must be readily available via phone during the tournament.
- If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation or misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the match official and tournament director immediately following the incident in question.
- Tournament director will confer with the tournament committee. The decision of the Tournament Committee is final.
- The WIAA Expulsion Rules will be followed.

EVENT STAFFING/TABLE HELP

- The host school will provide the scorekeepers to work each Mat table.
- Scoring will be logged into Track Wrestling at each mat.
- If score needs to be changed, the head Track Wrestling Representative will be notified.

ATHLETIC TRAINERS/MEDICAL STAFF

There will be an athletic trainer on site, however, teams need to bring their own medical kits fully stocked.

AWARDS POLICY

- Medals will be awarded to the first-place finishers in each weight class. Ribbons will be awarded for additional placers, per league policy.
- Individual awards will be presented during the championship session.

HOSPITALITY ROOM

There will NOT be food provided in the hospitality room at this event. Schools should coordinate with their own programs if wanting to provide food for coaches.

PASS LIST

- Each team will be given the following passes: 1 pass for each participant, 4 coach's passes, 2 managers/statistician passes.
- Table help provided by the host school and additional help from visiting schools will not be offered free admission.
- Approved Passes- District 1, With ID: WOA, WSSAAA, WIAA, WSCA, WIAA Seed Committee
- Cheer squads of participating schools will be admitted in full uniform, with advisor.

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE INFORMATION

DOORS OPEN- Doors open for spectators at 2:30pm. Absolutely **NO** spectators will be permitted in the venue prior to 2:30pm.

CONCESSIONS- Concession Stand will be available, No outside food is allowed on site. For Wrestlers, they can bring in what they need to eat pre-tournament.

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS- Gym Floor around the mats is reserved for players, coaches, match officials, and tournament personal. All fans must remain in the grandstands.

SPECTATORS- need to be seated in bleachers. Absolutely no spectators are permitted on the mats, or between the mats.

SUPERVISORS- School supervisors of participating schools should check in with the site manager. School supervisors are responsible in helping maintain good sportsmanship and behavior of their fans.

TEAM AREA- The bleachers opposite the gym entrance are team seating only. Absolutely no spectators permitted.

LOCKER ROOMS- will be available for team use. Locker rooms will not have supervision and items should not be left in the locker room. Host sites are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

PARKING- If needed, overflow parking is available next door at Heatherwood Middle School.

BUSSES

BUSSES: Please follow the green route on the map below. Busses should drop athletes directly in front of the gym, then continue on the green route to park behind the school. Busses can return to pick up athletes following the red route.
