2026 Boys Wrestling District Schedule

Saturday, February 7, 2026
7:30AM – Doors open for Participants. Locker rooms and check scales will be available
*** Do not arrive on campus prior to 7:30am – doors will not open early
8:00AM – Weigh-in will be completed by weight class.
*** All participants must be in the weigh-in area by 7:55AM. Line up by weight class WITH ID .
9:00AM – Doors will open for Spectators
9:15AM – Coaches meeting will begin
10:00AM – Round 1
11:55 AM – Round 2
1:50PM – Round 3
3:45PM – Round 4
5:00PM – Finals – Awards
*** These championship rounds follow the 16 wrestler brackets with consolation brackets running simultaneously. Only break will be to set up the finals after all place matches have concluded.

Weigh-ins: All athletes will need Photo I.D. (School ID/Driver's License) for weigh-ins. All wrestlers are to be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area during the weigh-in period – this will be strictly followed. During the weigh-in process no activities that promote hydration or dehydration will be allowed. Weigh-in will be completed by weight class. The head referee plus tournament manager will serve as weigh-ins officials. A coach must be present when wrestlers weigh in.

Mats: Four mats will be used for Rounds 1 through 4. One mat for finals

Buses: Athletes should be dropped off in front of the gym. After a bus has unloaded, please ask drivers to pull out of the parking lot and move over by the tennis courts on Jamison St.

Wrestling Area/Locker Rooms: Only wrestlers, coaches, officials and designated school staff are permitted in the wrestling area.

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Concessions: Provided at the Southeast corner of the Gym.

Hospitality Room: Sedro-Woolley HS will provide food for coaches/managers and officials only.

Apparel Purchases: Apparel will be open to all participants and spectators on Saturday.

Trainer/Taping: Athletic trainer will be onsite. Each team is responsible for its own tape and supplies.

Games Committee: Any disputes occurring at the tournament should be presented immediately to the Head Official. The Head Official will notify the Tournament Manager (Kevin Owen) and he will confer with the Games Committee to hear the protest. The Games Committee decision will be final. The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32 – Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed. The Tournament Games Committee will consist of: Head Official, Tournament Manager and Two coaches will be appointed at the pre-tournament coaches meeting

Awards: Medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th. **No team awards other than 1st place.**

All wrestlers will wear their school warm-ups on the podium. NO HATS, HOODS, OR HEADPHONES ON THE PODIUM OR FOR WIAA STATE PROGRAM PHOTOS

Qualifiers: The top EIGHT (8) wrestlers advancing to the WIAA Mat Classic XXXVII at the Tacoma Dome on February 19-20, 2026. The 9th place finisher will be the District 1 North alternate to state.

Bracketing: Brackets will be posted on TrackWrestling.com by 2/16/2026.
