

# 2026 3A/2A/1A Sea-King District 2 Girls Bowling Championships

## Timeline:

## State allocations:

- 3A: Top three (3) teams and top seven (7) individuals from non-qualifying teams.
- 2A: Top team (1) and top three (3) individuals from non-qualifying teams.

## Tournament format:

The District tournament consists of two (2) regular games and five (5) Baker-format games. All qualifying teams and individuals will bowl the regular games, with cumulative scores being used to determine the District Individual Champion as well as the individual State Qualifiers. *Note: A bowler must bowl the entirety of the two games to be considered for an individual State entry.*

Following the completion of the regular games, the two teams (regardless of classification) furthest from State qualifying scores will be eliminated from the Bakers. The final total pinfall for the two (2) regular games plus the five (5) Bakers will determine the District Team Champion as well as the Team State Qualifiers.

In the event of a team tie for either first place OR the final State berth, a five frame Baker roll-off (starting frame 6) will be used to break the tie. If still tied at the conclusion of Baker roll-off, a sudden death roll-off will commence. Teams will alternate shots and bowlers (no lineup changes from who began the Baker roll-off) until someone with the highest first ball pinfall breaks the tie.

## Substitutions/Lineup changes:

Up to two (2) substitutions can be made during a regular game however there is no re-entry until the game is over unless an injury occurs after the 2<sup>nd</sup> substitution. (If that occurs injured bowler is no longer allowed to re-enter the tournament.) The lineup cannot change during a regular game unless due to direct substitution. The lineup can be adjusted at the start of each Baker. 8 Schools will bowl the Baker portion of the tournament.

## Dress Code:

Per WIAA, all players and coaches must be in a collared shirt with the school name on the back. No jeans, shorts, miniskirts, sweats, caps or headbands allowed.

## Conduct of Students and Coaches and Spectators:

Matches are to be treated as an extension of the classroom. No electronic devices are allowed for use in the settee during matches. Only coaches and players are allowed in the settee area during warmups and match play.

Spectators must follow the current sportsmanship guidelines of the WIAA and whatever mandates the facilities are required to follow to stay open.

**Games Committee:**

Per District policy, each tournament will appoint a Tournament Games Committee which will be empowered to make decisions or judgements deemed necessary that extend beyond the scope outlined in this document. Any items for consideration by the Games Committee must be formally submitted for Tournament Director. *The Games Committee will consist of: Tournament Director, District representative, and two coaches (one from each classification).*

**Admissions:**

All spectators except children under 6 are required to pay an admissions fee. Please communicate the information to your fans prior to the tournament so they will arrive prepared to pay the admissions. Purchase tickets in advance on [Go Fan](#).

**Fees:**

Participating schools will be billed by District 2 following the event at a per-game rate determined by the venue.
