Driving Directions to the Stadium

Take I-5 to the 56th Avenue exit West Travel West on 56th Street (it will become Cirque Drive) for approximately 3.25 miles to Bridgeport Way. Turn right and proceed to 40th Street. Turn left onto 40th Street and travel west through a 4-way stop and down the hill. Curtis High School is on the right hand side. The team bus will turn right into the second drive past the CHS reader board and drop athletes and coaches in front of the main gym and aquatic center. Teams will enter through the main gate, south of the main/home grandstand.

Field

CHS Stadium playing surface is synthetic grass by FieldTurf. Soccer lines are marked in yellow.

Game Programs

Game rosters listing all of the participants will be provided by Curtis High School.

Administrator Supervision

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. Please contact Shelly Nyegaard with the name of the supervisor prior to game day.

COVID GIUDELINES

Spectators will be expected to follow State Dept. of Health and Pierce County Dept. of Health guidelines, wearing masks and observing social distancing as directed.

Spectator Seating

All spectators will enter from the South through the main ticket booth and sit in the main grandstand in designated areas for each school. The visitor grandstand will not be used.

Ticket Gates will open at one hour prior to game time. For non-GoFan purchasers, **Cash only**. **No bills larger than \$20.** League Passes will **NOT** be accepted. West Central District, Washington State Coaches Association (WSCA) and Washington Secondary School Athletic Administrator passes will be honored at the pass gate (also located at the south entrance main ticket booth).

Students may not leave and re-entry the stadium during the event.

Signs and School Banners

No signs other than the official school banners will be allowed in the stadium.

Game Ball

Game balls provided by the WIAA. Baden Precision is the state authorized game ball.

Team Benches

The team benches will be on the north side of the field in front of the visitor grandstand (no spectators allowed in the visitor grandstand). Only participants (coaches, players, managers, and trainers) will be allowed on the field.

Uniforms

The Home Teams (bottom of the bracket) will wear dark-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams (top of the bracket) will wear light-colored jerseys.

Dressing Rooms

The dressing rooms for teams are located in the Curtis High School Gym. Locker rooms will be open one hour prior to game time. Rooms will be secured while teams are on the field.

Pre-game Schedule

Teams will be allowed on the field no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the game. During the warm up period referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period (1:00 on the scoreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions

The starting line-up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to the middle of the field and form a single line to the west (scoreboard side of mid field) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the home Team is being introduced. After the introduction, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the west end of the stadium for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Competition Committee

The competition committee will include the Head Referee assigned by Pierce County Soccer Referee Association, Field Supervisor (Tom Gallo), and Site Playoff Manager (Gary Spidahl).

Tie Games

The method of breaking ties will be as follows:

Two golden goal five (5) minute overtime periods. A coin toss shall be held prior to the first overtime period as per Law 8. At the end of the first overtime period, teams shall change ends. If still tied at the end of the second overtime, penalty kicks will decide the outcome. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken. Each coach will select five (5) players, including the goalkeeper, only players who are on the field of play at the end of the match are eligible to take the kicks. A coin toss shall be held with the winning team having choice of kicking first or second. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow up on the kick. The defending team may change goalkeepers with an eligible player prior to each penalty kick. Following the five (5) kicks, the team scoring on the greatest number of kicks shall be declared the winner. If the score remains tied, each coach shall select five (5) different players than the first five (5) to take kicks until one team has scored a goal more than the other from the same number of kicks.

Medical Services

A certified athletic trainer will be on site responding to the needs of athletes before, during and after the games.
