PARKING

DRESSING ROOMS

MASKS MUST BE WORN INSIDE THE LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms will be secured during game play. Teams from the 5:00pm game will need to bring their items with them out to the field after halftime

ICE

SIDELINES

Team benches are on the respective sidelines (Home-West, Visitor-East).

The number of people on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, team physician and trainers. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

Athletes on the sidelines will support 6 feet social distancing and follow DOH's mandate on masking. Subs will wear a pennie while on the bench or warming up

NO SEEDS OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ON TURF. SPORT DRINKS MUST BE KEPT ON THE TRACK, WATER ONLY IS ALLOWED ON THE PLAYING FIELD. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.

GAME BALL

Game balls will be provided by the WIAA. The state adopted ball is the **Baden Precision**.

GAME JERSEYS

Home team will wear DARK colored jerseys. Visiting team will wear LIGHT colored jerseys.

PRE-GAME WARMUP

Home team will warm up at South end of field and use the west benches. Visiting team will warm up at North (Scoreboard) end of field and use the east benches.

PRE-GAME INTRODUCTIONS

There will be pre-game introductions of individual players. Players and refs will walkout to the field together after introductions and prior to the playing of the National Anthem.

FLAG CEREMONY / NATIONAL ANTHEM

Flag ceremony will start after line-ups have been announced.

IN THE EVENT OF A TIE

If at the end of regulation, the game has ended in a tie, we will follow the NFHS rules on Tie-Breakers:

38.6.0 NFHS RULE EXCEPTION

38.6.1 Tie-breakers

- A. Tie-breakers may be used if approved by the league or the teams involved.
- B. The following procedures will be utilized for all soccer playoff contests:
- 1. Two (2) sudden death five (5) minute overtimes. If still tied, penalty kicks will decide the results.
- 2. Only the 11 players involved in the final minute of the final overtime will be allowed to kick any penalty kicks.

POST-GAME
