ROSTER & ELIGIBILITY:

Your WCD Volleyball Roster is due no later than the end of the day **Monday November 8th 2021 by 1 pm**. All rosters should be on WPA or MaxPreps where I can pull them for the tournament.

TEAM ENTRANCE:

All players, coaches, and managers/trainers must enter the building through the Pass Gate which is located on the front side of the gym – near the main entrance. – SEE ATTACHED MAP

TEAM ENTRY:

Each team will be allowed a roster of 14 players and 6 coaches/managers (7 if you have a trainer/doctor). These numbers are the same as the State Tournament. Only those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench. All players and coaches/managers should enter together through the team entrance.

PASSES:

Only WCD Executive Board, SWD Executive Board, WSCA & WSSAAA passes will be accepted.

Any other passes including League or Season Passes WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

PASS GATE & PASS LIST:

The pass gate will be next to the main ticket entrance. Administrators and Faculty who are on the pass list must be in the area your students are sitting in during matches. Your assistance is valuable and important in maintaining a positive sportsmanship like atmosphere at the tournament. Spectators wishing to leave and return for a later match will be stamped.

Your supervision pass list must be emailed to Steve Taylor and Kathy Cognasso, Tournament Director, no later than noon on **Monday November 8**th **2019 by 1 pm** staylor@osd.wednet.edu **AND** kcognasso@osd.wednet.edu

TEAM INTRODUCTIONS:

Team introductions will be made for the Championship game on Saturday only. All players and coaches for both teams will be introduced.

OFFICIALS & SCORERS:

The Tournament director will arrange for officials from officiating boards located in District III & IV. **These officials will serve as game officials, line persons, and scorekeepers**. Assigning secretaries from each board represented determine all official assignments. One official will serve as the tournament official coordinator to be sure all matches assigned are covered by a full set of officials.

The home team must provide a libero tracker at the scorer's table. If only one team uses a libero, that team must supply the libero tracker at the scorer's table. The WCD will not supply a libero tracker. Although the scoreboards will be operated by tournament staff, they will not be the official score of the match.

GAME BALLS:

Game balls will be provided. Game balls will be Baden Precision VX5VC, the Official ball of the WCD. Teams will use their own balls for warm up

COURT ASSIGNMENTS:

Drawn by West Central District Volleyball Committee. The Tournament Directors shall have the authority to make adjustments as necessary.

TRAINING ROOM:

The Capital training room will be open to provide ice for teams when requested. The training room is located down the long hall between the main and auxiliary gyms near the pass gate entrance. You will need to provide your own athletic trainer, tape, and supplies.

LOCKER ROOMS:

The girls' locker room will be the only one available. Please follow sign to locker room

TOWELS & PADLOCKS:

All teams must furnish your own towels. If you wish to leave anything in either locker room you must provide your own locks. The locker room doors will not be locked during the tournament to allow team access at all times.

CHEERLEADERS:

Cheerleaders will be admitted through the pass gate only and must be in uniform. During matches officials and/or the Tournament Director will determine what areas are suitable for cheer squads. For the safety of everyone involved, cheer squads must stay in the designated areas.

FILMING:

There are limited power outlets at each court. Bring extra batteries. Filming must take place in the stands since the floor is a playable area.

TEAM BUSES & TEAM VANS:

All team buses and team van parking is located on the west side of the school building and main gym. Please park busses and vans in the area closest to Conger Avenue. See the driving directions on page 6 of this syllabus. The team will enter through the main spectator entrance of the gymnasium. Signs will direct teams and spectators.

SPECTATOR PARKING:

Spectator parking is located at the lower lot in front of the gym.

SPECTATOR SEATING:

All spectators are required to be seated during the match. Spectators may not stand near the courts and must remain in the stands. All video-taping must also be done in the stands.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- 1. Bands are not permitted at this event.
- 2. Only an official school banner (made of cloth or vinyl) will be permitted.
- 3. Artificial noisemakers of any kind are not permitted and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors or tournament staff.
- 4. Throwing confetti or other materials is not permitted.

The use of tobacco or tobacco products on Olympia School District property (including parking lots) is prohibited.

CONCESSIONS:

The Thurston County DOH mandates that there will be no Indoor Concessions. there will not be food or drink allowed in the. The concession stand in the gym foyer will be open during most of the tournament's hours. All food and drink purchased at the concession stand must be consumed outside before re-entering the facility.

PRE MATCH WARM-UP:

The official warm-up time will be 20 minutes, with eight (8) minutes of shared court time, followed by six (6) minutes for the visiting, followed by six (6) minutes for the home team. Hitting or serving the ball into the opponent's court is not allowed during the shared court time. Teams are not allowed to warm-up on the sidelines or endlines while waiting for their court time.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

2017 National Federation rules will be used with the following exceptions:

- 1. Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 sets. The first four sets to 25 and the fifth set to 15 with no cap.
- 2. Each team must furnish their own warm-up balls. Match balls will be furnished by the tournament manager.
- 3. All game officials, line judges and official scorekeepers will be furnished by the Officials Association.

DESIGNATION OF HOME TEAM:

- 1. The home team will be the bottom team in each bracket.
- 2. The home team warms up first.

GAMES OR APPEALS COMMITTEE:

Will consist of: Tournament Manager, Head Official and coach from opposite side of the bracket.
