Guests can purchase WCD tickets online (see QR code) and [GoFan](#) (search "WCD") or via the GoFan app. There will no longer be ticket booths so fans can go straight to the gates, have their ticket(s) redeemed on their smart device, and watch the action!



GATES OPEN

ONLY the South ticket gates next to the parking lot will be open for spectators starting at 6:30 PM.

BAG CHECKS

Sparks Stadium personnel conduct bag checks prior to spectators entering the facility.

Examples of items not allowed on PSD property: Firearms and ammunition, explosives/fireworks, gas-based portable heaters, illegal narcotics/drug paraphernalia, alcoholic beverages and marijuana, knives (regardless of length), glass bottles and containers, non-service animals.

SPECTATOR PARKING

The actual paved stadium parking lot on the south side of Sparks can accommodate 150 cars. There is curbside parking on surrounding streets or in the Puyallup Fair Red Lot immediately adjacent to Sparks Stadium on the south side of the facility.

Tailgating is not allowed on Puyallup SD property nor on Washington State Fair property.

SEATING

The tournament manager will assign each participating school a rooting section. The supervision of this section will be the responsibility of the school. Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time and are required to stay behind the fenced areas at all times.

Home Team Schools ([bottom on bracket](#)) will sit in the **EAST** half of the South grandstands (**see page 6 of this packet**). **Student seating** will be assigned where standing is allowed.

Visiting Team Schools ([top on bracket](#)) will sit in **WEST** half of the South grandstands (**see page 6 of this packet**). **Student seating** will be assigned where standing is allowed.

STUDENT CONDUCT

As games are school functions, students are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE PREMISES.** Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and/or other objects. Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

It is important that building **administrators** provide game supervision **in the stands** by promoting a safe enjoyable event for everyone. Please remind students to wear shirts, to observe the **stadium policy** of no body or face paint, no masks, and to observe good sportsmanship. If an issue with one of your students arises we will ask you to address it.

CONCESSIONS

No concessions will be available for this game.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms are and are located behind the South Grandstand. Locker rooms are for team use only. There are no public restrooms available in the locker rooms.

HALF TIME ENTERTAINMENT

Halftime is 10 minutes. There will be no half time field shows, i.e., Band, Drill, or Cheer.

SIGNS & SCHOOL BANNERS

NO signs other than the **OFFICIAL SCHOOL BANNER** will be allowed.

GAME PROGRAMS

The Puyallup School District Athletic Department will take responsibility for the production and/or sale of game programs.

BAND & ROOTER BUSES

Home and Visiting School bands - please park band bus in **SW TEAM Parking Area** and enter the South grandstands from that point.

Rooter Buses will be parked **FREE of charge** in the Puyallup Fair Red Lot immediately adjacent to Sparks Stadium on the south side of the facility.

TEAM PERSONNEL PASS GATE

Home and visiting teams, coaches, and personnel will be admitted through the **SW Pass Gate** and park their bus in the **SW Team Parking Area** (please make arrangements to enter as a team at the same time).

TEAM ROSTERS

LIMIT: 22 players

6 Support personal (coaches, managers, statistician, medical)

The number of people on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, ball boy/girl, team physician or trainer. The only coaches permitted to be on the sidelines during a state playoff contest shall be limited to the coaches who have been named as soccer coaches by the school district for the regular season. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

PLEASE E-MAIL ROSTER ASAP

SIDELINES & TEAM BENCH

Both team benches will be placed on the **SAME** sideline (North side of the stadium) and on the TRACK Surface. All Fans are restricted to the **South Grandstand**. Benches are separated by 10 yards and off the turf.

- Home team (**bottom on bracket**) will warm up on the East end of the field (street side) and occupy the **EAST TEAM BENCH**.
- Visiting Team (**top on bracket**) will warm up on the West end (scoreboard side) of the field and occupy the **WEST TEAM BENCH**.

NO SEEDS OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ALLOWED ON THE TURF. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.

LOCKER ROOMS

HOME SCHOOL: will use the South Grandstand locker room.

VISITORS: will use the North Grandstand locker room.

GAME JERSEYS

HOME SCHOOL: will wear **DARK COLORED JERSEYS**

VISITORS: will wear **LIGHT COLORED JERSEYS**

MEDICAL

There will be one Certified Athletic Trainer from Olympic Sports & Spine onsite.

PRE-GAME WARMUP

The field will be available at least 30 minutes before the contest

PRE-GAME SCHEDULE

The following time schedule will be kept, using the stadium scoreboard clock which will be set to reach zero at 7:25 pm. With five minutes remaining, the pre-game order looks like:

- As clock reaches zero – teams line up at their respective team benches
- INTERNATIONAL WALKOUT to the center of the field (introduction of officials)
- Team introductions, as follows:
 - + Visiting team – reserves, starters, and coaches
 - + Home team - reserves, starters, and coaches
- Teams turn to face the American flag on the west end of the field for the National Anthem.

BALLS

The HOME TEAM is responsible for providing the game ball. Home team ball is subject to referee approval.

TIE GAMES-STATE TOURNAMENT

FIFA RULES will be used in all State playoff games with WIAA published exceptions.

The method of breaking ties will be as follows:

Two (2) golden goal (5) minute overtimes. A coin toss shall be held prior to the first overtime as per Law 8. At the end of the first overtime period, teams shall change ends. If still tied at the end of the second overtime, penalty kicks will decide the outcome. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken. Each coach will select five (5) players, including the goalkeeper, only players who are *on the field* of play at the end of the match are eligible take the kicks. A coin toss shall be held with the winning team having choice of kicking first or second. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow up on the kick. The defending team may change goalkeepers with an eligible player prior to each penalty kick. Following the five (5) kicks, the team scoring on the greatest number of kicks shall be declared the winner. If the score remains tied, each coach shall select five (5) different players than the first five to take kicks until one team has scored a goal more than the other from the same number of kicks.

OFFICIALS

Four WOA certified soccer officials will be assigned to each match by the Pierce County Soccer Referees Association.

GAMES COMMITTEE

The Games Committee, composed of a least three of the individuals listed above, will hear and decide on any protest and/or appeal.
