#### DIRECTIONS TO HARRY LANG STADIUM

#### **I-5 South from Seattle:**

Take exit 125 Bridgeport Way toward JBLM McChord Field. Turn right onto Bridgeport Way SW. Turn left onto 111<sup>th</sup> St SW. Drive a half mile and turn right into Harry Lang Stadium parking lot.

# I-5 North from Olympia:

Take exit 125 Bridgeport Way toward JBLM McChord Field. Turn left onto Bridgeport Way SW. Turn left onto 111<sup>th</sup> St. SW. Drive a half mile and turn right into Harry Lang Stadium parking lot.

#### **PARKING**

Buses can drop teams off in the bus loop in front of the stadium. Teams will enter on home side guess gate. Second game teams Home team will sit on home side and visiting team on visiting side: teams will sit in the stands until after the half time of the first game.

Parking for spectators is in the main parking lot off of 111<sup>th</sup> St. SW. Additional spectator and Bus parking is located in the Harry Lang Tennis Complex parking lot to the right of the Harry Lang Stadium main entrance.

# **STADIUM RE-ENTRY**

No PASS-OUT (re-entry) once admitted. This includes halftime. We will allow re-entry for emergencies at the discretion of stadium staff.

#### SUPERVISION PASSES

Participating schools will be allowed admission for four supervisors/Administrators and staff personnel who are expected to help supervise their school's students. Supervisors will be required to sign in. (see form on page 6)

E-MAIL THE ENCLOSED PASS LIST FORM TO THE GAME MANAGER NO LATER THAN Tuesday (11/1) at NOON. SUPERVISORS ENTER THROUGH THE MAIN TICKET GATE.

There will be no halftime show. Therefore, Dance/Drill team members must purchase a ticket

PASSES ACCEPTED: WSCA Coaches Association, WCD 3 passes, and WSSAAA pass.

NO OTHER SEASON PASSES WILL BE ACCEPTED (including league and school district passes)

#### **CONCESSIONS**

Will be provided through our main concession booth located next to the ticket gate.

# PRESS / TV / RADIO PASSES

May be obtained by contacting Game Manager, Bre Giove, and displaying an appropriate media pass.

Radio and TV broadcasts must submit an application and obtain approval through the West Central District Director.

# HALF TIME ENTERTAINMENT

Halftime is 10 minutes. There will be **NO HALF TIME** field shows, i.e., Band, Drill, or Cheer.

#### **SEATING**

WIAA tournament regulations state that a section of seating **must be available** for students who wish to stand for prolonged periods. (WIAA State Tournament Packet. PG. 6, Item M)

Home side will sit on the bench closes to the main score board on the home side of the stadium.

There is no standing at the fence in the grandstand. All spectators need to be in the grandstand and able to sit on a bench if the need arises.

Visiting teams will seat on the bench closes to the ticket gate.

# **BAND SEATING**

The home team band shall share the home school student section The visiting team band shall share the visiting school student section

# **TEAM ROSTERS**

LIMIT: 22 players and 6 Support personal (coaches, managers, statistician, medical)

The number of people on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, ball boy/girl, team physician or trainer. The only coaches permitted to be on the sidelines during a state or district playoff contest shall be limited to the coaches who have been named as soccer coaches by the school district for the regular season. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

# **SIDELINES & TEAM BENCH**

Team benches will be placed on the home side of the stadium.

Home team will warm up on the North end of the field and occupy the **NORTH TEAM BENCH**.

Visiting Team will warm up on the South end (main gate side) of the field and occupy the Visiting **TEAM BENCH**.

NO SHELLED SEEDS, SUGAR DRINKS (IE. GATORADE) OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ALLOWED ON THE TURF. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.

#### **SIGNS & SCHOOL BANNERS**

NO signs other than the OFFICIAL SCHOOL BANNER will be allowed.

#### **LOCKER ROOMS:**

HOME SCHOOL: will use the home locker room located under the Home grandstand on the north end. Second game team cannot use the locker rooms until after half time of the first game.

VISITORS: will use the visiting team locker room located under the visiting grandstand on the north end. Second game team cannot use the locker rooms until after half time of the first game.

#### **GAME JERSEYS**

HOME SCHOOL: (Auburn Mountainview) will wear DARK COLORED JERSEYS

VISITORS: (Lakes) will wear **LIGHT COLORED JERSEYS** 

# **MEDICAL**

There will be one Certified Athletic Trainer available for both teams, and located on the Home team bench side of the stadium

#### STUDENT CONDUCT

As games are school functions, ALL SPECTATORS are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE PREMISES**. Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and/or other objects. Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

It is important that building **administrators** provide game supervision **in the stands** by promoting a safe enjoyable event for everyone. Please remind students to wear shirts, to observe the **stadium policy** of no body or face paint, no masks, and to observe good sportsmanship. If an issue with one of your students arises we will ask you to address it.

# **FAN AND SPECTATORS**

The tournament manager will assign each participating school a rooting section. The supervision of this section will be the responsibility of the school. Spectators are not allowed on the track or playing field at any time, and are required to stay behind the fenced areas at all times.

#### **DUTIES OF SCHOOL SUPERVISORS**

- Report to the tournament manager at least 30 minutes prior to their team's match.
- Must wear supervisor/school identification so that it is visible and easily seen.
- Sit with your school's student body and fans while your team is competing.
- Be active and visible in the cheering section with your student body and fans during all contests in order to discourage problems.
- Be willing to approach students and/or community representatives who display inappropriate behavior.
- Notify tournament staff of potential problem individuals.
- Be of assistance as requested by facility security staff or tournament management staff.
- Be sure aisles and stairways are kept clear in the stands.
- Keep your students and fans from entering the playing surface.
- Assist in the orderly flow of traffic of fans entering and exiting the facility.
- At the conclusion of your game, assist your school's students and fans in leaving the bleachers.
- Foster the traits of good sportsmanship.

# PRE-GAME WARMUP

Teams will be allowed on the field for Pre-game warm up starting at 4:45/.

#### PRE-GAME SCHEDULE

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 30 minutes. The following time schedule will be kept, using the stadium scoreboard clock:

- Teams can warm-up all the way to 00:00 on the scoreboard. When the warm-up time expires, teams need to clear the field and organize on their sideline in front of their team bench.
- Team introductions, as follows:
  - + Visiting team will be announced first, proceeding down the roster in a numerical order.
  - + Home team will be announced second, proceeding down the roster in a numerical order.
- Players should remain on the field, turn and face the flag (North end) and we will conduct the National Anthem.
- After the anthem, players turn to face each other and advance to midfield to shake hands before returning to their bench

Note: The stadium scoreboard clock will be set to allow for introductions prior to the scheduled kick-off time.

# **CLOCK**

The official time will be kept on the field by the center official. The stadium clock is unofficial.

# **GAMES COMMITTEE**

The Games Committee will include the following:

- Tournament/Event Manager Bre Giove
- Head Official TBD
- A coach, athletic director, or school administrator present at the game TBD
- WOA 4th Official TBD
- Another event staff member TBD

The Games Committee, composed of a least three and no more than 5 of the individuals listed above, will hear and decide on any protest and/or appeal.

# TIE GAMES-STATE TOURNAMENT PROCESS

The method of breaking ties will be as follows:

1) Two (2) golden goal (5) minute overtime periods.

A coin toss shall be held prior to the first overtime as per Law 8. At the end of the first overtime period, teams shall change ends. If still tied at the end of the second overtime, penalty kicks (kicks from the mark) will decide the outcome.

- 2) Kicks from the Mark
  - The head referee shall choose the goal at which all of the kicks from the penalty mark shall be taken
  - Each coach will select five (5) players, as well as the goalkeeper, to participate in the kicks.
  - Only players who are on the field of play at the end of the second overtime period are eligible to take the kicks.
  - A coin toss shall be held with the winning team having choice of kicking first or second.
  - Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow up on the kick. The defending team may change goalkeepers with an eligible player prior to each penalty kick.
  - Following the five (5) kicks, the team scoring on the greatest number of kicks shall be declared the winner.
  - If the score remains tied, each coach shall select five (5) different players (other than the first five kickers) until one team has scored a goal more than the other from the same number of kicks.
  - If the kicks continue through all eligible players (those that were on the field at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> overtime) the teams can re-select their next 5 kickers from those that are eligible, regardless of the previous kicking order.

#### **BALLS**

The WCD will furnish three Baden game-approved balls.

#### **RESTROOMS**

Restrooms are located under the grandstand on the south (main gate) end. Locker rooms are for team use only. There are restrooms connected to the team rooms and are only to be used by team members.

# **OFFICIALS**

Four (4) WOA certified soccer officials will be assigned to the match. Officials are selected by their association to work at this tournament and are assigned by the PCSRA. The officials will be head referee and two assistant referees along with a fourth official who acts as the timer and scorer. Official assessors may also be assigned.
