Field Surface:

Peninsula College playing surface is an artificial turf and was installed in the summer of 2010. Soccer lines are inlaid in White. **No food or sun flower-seeds allowed on the turf, only water is permitted on the field.** http://athletics.pencol.edu/pc-athletics/facilities

Team Rosters:

Please have <u>full page district</u> roster up-dated on WPA by Monday, November 2-4. Rosters will be pulled straight from your WPA site.

Administrator Supervisor:

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. Please complete the attached pass list form and return by 9:00 AM on Tuesday, November 1. Only those supervisors, whose names appear on the pass-list, will be allowed free entry. Once on site, the supervisor should check in with the Site Playoff Manager or Main Ticket Gate.

Game Ball:

The Home Team should furnish three game balls (3). Baden Perfection Thermo Soccer ball ST7. http://wiaa.com/ConDocs/Con1927/WIAA%20Official%20Ball.pdf

Team Benches:

Both team benches will be located on the South side of the field. The Home Team bench will be located East of midfield, and the Visiting Team bench will be located West of midfield.

Only participants (coaches, players, managers, trainers, and cheer staff in uniform) will be allowed on the field. Each school will be allowed two field passes for student reporters or photographers.

Uniforms:

The Home Teams will wear dark-colored jerseys. The Visiting Teams will wear light-colored jerseys.

Shoes:

Most of the players wear the same cleats they would use on a natural grass field. Plastic molded shoes.

Locker Rooms are not available for this event.

Pre-game Schedule:

Pre-game warm up will be a minimum of 20 minutes. During the warm up period, referees will inspect equipment and meet with team captains. With one minute remaining in the warm up period, (1:00 on the sc oreboard) teams should line up in front of their respective benches.

Player Introductions:

The starting line-up for the Visiting Team will be introduced first. Each player should proceed to midfield and form a single line to the South (ticket gate side of midfield) facing the main grandstand. They should remain in line while the Home Team is being introduced. When introduced, the Home Team will line up to the North of midfield (scoreboard side of midfield). After the introductions, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag at the end of the stadium (south end) for the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion, teams should return to their respective benches.

Medical Services:

A certified athletic trainer should be on site responding to needs of athletes before, during and after the games.

Admission (set by the WCD/WIAA Board): For the 2022-2023 school year, GoFan will be the official online ticket source for the WCD post-season events. All tickets for the WCD will be sold through GoFan only.



Guests can purchase WCD tickets online (see QR below) and **Go Fan** (search "WCD") or via the **Go Fan app**. There will no longer be ticket booths so fans can go straight to the gates, have their ticket(s) redeemed on their smart device with a gate worker, and watch the action!

Ticket Gates will open 1 hour before game time. No league supervision passes will be accepted. All WIAA rosters and pass lists will be accepted.
