PARKING

Spectator parking can be accommodated on the Kent-Meridian HS campus (East Side of stadium). Bus and team personnel (pass list) can be accommodated on the visitor (West Side of stadium).

TICKETING

For the 2022-2023 school year, GoFan will be the official online ticket source for the WCD postseason events. All tickets for the WCD will be sold through <u>GoFan</u> only.

Guests can purchase WCD tickets online (see QR below) and <u>GoFan</u> (search "WCD") or via the GoFan app. There will no longer be ticket booths so fans can go straight to the gates, have their ticket(s) redeemed on their smart device, and watch the action!

Admission Prices - No cash will be accepted.

STADIUM RE-ENTRY

Students leaving the stadium will not be allowed to re-enter. Adults will be stamped for in/out.

SUPERVISION PASSES

Participating schools will receive <u>FOUR (4) SUPERVISION PASSES</u> (see form on page 5) for School Board, Administrators, and staff personnel who are expected to help supervise their school's students.

Cheerleaders IN UNIFORM will be admitted free.

PASSES ACCEPTED: WIAA, WSCA, WSSAAA, WCD 3.

NO OTHER PASSES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

CONCESSIONS

There will be no concessions on site.

PRESS / TV / RADIO PASSES

May be obtained by contacting Game Manager.

HALF TIME ENTERTAINMENT

Halftime is 10 minutes. There will be **NO HALF TIME** field shows.

SEATING

WIAA tournament regulations state that a section of seating **must be available** for students who wish to stand for prolonged periods.

Home school (Curtis, Tahoma) will sit in the <u>NORTH</u> half of the East grandstands. Student seating will be in the section immediately <u>North</u> (and adjacent) to the center section of the East grandstand. *WARNING: Viewing the game from the Student Section may be obstructed due to prolonged standing*.

Visiting School (Bellarmine, Puyallup) will sit in <u>SOUTH</u> half of the East grandstands. Student seating will be in the section immediately <u>South</u> (and adjacent) to the center section of the South grandstand. *WARNING: Viewing the game from the Student Section may be obstructed due to prolonged standing*.

PARTICIPATION/TEAM PASSES

The Home and Visiting team, coaches, and personnel will be admitted through the **WEST SIDE GATE** and park their bus in the **WEST SIDE Parking LOT**.

TEAM ROSTERS

LIMIT: 22 players 6 Support personnel (coaches, managers, statistician, medical)

The number of people (28) on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, ball boy/girl, team physician or trainer. The only coaches permitted to be on the sidelines during a state playoff contest shall be limited to the coaches who have been named as

soccer coaches by the school district for the regular season. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

WARM-UP

Teams will have a 15-minute pregame warm-up at the competition site.

SIDELINES & TEAM BENCH

Both team benches will be placed on the <u>SAME</u> sideline (West side of the stadium) and on the TRACK Surface. All Fans are restricted to the **East Grandstand**. Benches are separated by 10 yards and off the turf. A Fourth (4th) Registered Soccer Official is placed at a table between the benches to assist in Substitution and Bench Control.

Home team (Curtis, Tahoma) will warm up on the North end (HILL) of the field and occupy the NORTH TEAM BENCH.

Visiting Team (Bellarmine, Puyallup) will warm up on the SOUTH end (Scoreboard) of the field and occupy the SOUTH TEAM BENCH.

NO SEEDS OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ALLOWED ON THE TURF. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.

SIGNS & SCHOOL BANNERS

NO signs other than the OFFICIAL SCHOOL BANNER will be allowed.

MATCH ROSTERS

The KENT School District Athletic Department will post team rosters at the stadium.

LOCKER ROOMS

HOME SCHOOL: (Curtis, Tahoma) will use the NORTH Grandstand locker room. VISITORS: (Bellarmine, Puyallup) will use the SOUTH Grandstand locker room. Teams in GAME 1 will remove all team and personal items from the locker at the end of half time.

GAME JERSEYS

HOME SCHOOL: (Curtis, Tahoma) will wear DARK COLORED JERSEYS VISITORS: (Bellarmine, Puyallup) will wear LIGHT COLORED JERSEYS

MEDICAL

There will be one Certified Athletic Trainer from Olympic Sport and Spine available for both teams.

STUDENT CONDUCT

As games are school functions, students are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. <u>UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE</u> <u>PREMISES</u>. Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and/or other objects. Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

It is important that building **administrators** provide game supervision **in the stands** by promoting a safe enjoyable event for everyone. Please remind students to wear shirts, to observe the **stadium policy** of no body or face paint, no masks, no bandanas and to observe good sportsmanship. If an issue with one of your students arises, we will ask you to address it.

PRE-GAME WARMUP

The field will be available 30 minutes before the contest. (5:00 PM and 7:00PM)

PRE-GAME INTRODUCTIONS

Players will be introduced prior to the start of the game. We ask that each team line up along their sideline in numerical order for introductions and take one step forward when named and then step back to the sideline. The visiting team will be introduced first, followed by the home team starters. We ask that both teams remain on the sideline and face the flag located at the **SOUTH** end of the stadium (scoreboard). The National Anthem and/or Pledge will take place after the introduction of the teams. There will not be an additional flag ceremony prior to the second game.

FLAG CEREMONY / NATIONAL ANTHEM

Flag ceremony will start at approximately **4:57 PM and 6:57 PM**. In the absence of a band/singer the Pledge of Allegiance or National Anthem will be led by the PA Announcer.

TIE GAMES-STATE TOURNAMENT

After a 5-minute break at the conclusion of play, two (2) golden goal five (5) minute overtime periods will be utilized. If still tied, kicks from the mark will decide the result of the match. Only players on the field at the conclusion of the last overtime period can be used for kicks from the mark.
