## **PARKING**

All staff, player/personnel, and spectator parking is located in the Federal Way High School parking lot on the Home side of the stadium.

## **STADIUM RE-ENTRY**

Students leaving stadium will not be allowed to return. Adults will be stamped for in/out.

## **SUPERVISION PASSES**

Pass list must be emailed in by noon the day before your team is to play. Participating schools may list **4 supervision** personnel on a pass list who are expected to help supervise their school's students. Schools may also submit the names of school board members and superintendent.

**Each school must provide a supervisor for their game**

Band Director and band members **IN UNIFORM** will be admitted free.

FACULTY PASSES, EMPLOYEE PASSES, SENIOR PASSES, AND/OR SEASON  
PASSES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

## **CONCESSIONS**

The concession stands will be operated by the Federal Way Public Schools programs, and is located in the upper concourse.

## **LIVE STREAM**

## **HALF TIME ENTERTAINMENT**

Halftime is 10 minutes. Each school shall be allowed 4 minutes for performance by band and /or cheer team. The band director shall consult with the game manager regarding halftime and pre-game activities by no later than the end of the day prior to the game.

## **VISITING SEATING**

Home schools will sit in the North side of the grandstand.  
Visiting schools will sit in the South side of the grandstand.

## **TEAM ROSTERS**

Will be pulled from WPAN site at 9:00am on game day.

## **SIGNS & SCHOOL BANNERS**

Official school banners and handheld signs that are positive and directed at the school's team are permitted. **Halftime crash banners are not allowed.**

## **GAME PROGRAMS**

Team rosters will be available at the ticket booth

## **BUS PARKING**

## **DRESSING ROOMS**

Each team will be issued a locker room that only they will have access to. Locker rooms will be made available to teams one hour prior to kickoff.

## **MEDICAL**

Athletic Training services are provided by Olympic Sport and Spine.

## **STUDENT CONDUCT**

As these games are school functions, students are expected to exercise good judgement in their conduct and dress. **UNACCEPTABLE CONDUCT IS CAUSE FOR EJECTION FROM THE PREMISES.** Artificial noisemakers, such as air horns, bells, whistles, etc. are prohibited, as is the throwing of confetti, and or other objects. Megaphones are to be used by the cheer staff only.

## **ICE**

Ice is available at stadium.

## **SIDELINES**

Teams will line up on the West side of the stadium facing their spectator section. Home-Northwest, and Away-Southwest.

The number of people on the sidelines is limited to: team members in uniform, coaches, and managers, team physician and trainers. All other persons without sideline authorization from game manager will be escorted to grandstand.

Subs will wear a pennie while on the bench or warming up

**NO GUM, SEEDS, DRINKS(water ok), OR FOOD OF ANY KIND ON TURF OR TRACK AREA. WATER ONLY IS ALLOWED ON THE PLAYING FIELD. SCHOOLS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE BILLED FOR CLEANUP COSTS.**

## **GAME BALL**

Game balls will be provided by the WCD III.

## **GAME JERSEYS**

Home team will wear DARK colored jerseys.  
Visiting team will wear LIGHT colored jerseys.

## **PRE-GAME WARMUP**

Home team will warm up at North end of field and use the Northwest benches.  
Visiting team will warm up at South end of field and use the Southwest benches.

## **PRE-GAME INTRODUCTIONS**

There will be pre-game introductions of individual players. Players and refs will walkout to the field together after introductions and prior to the playing of the National Anthem.

## **FLAG CEREMONY / NATIONAL ANTHEM**

Flag ceremony will start after line-ups have been announced.

## **IN THE EVENT OF A TIE**

If at the end of regulation, the game has ended in a tie, we will follow the NFHS rules on Tie-Breakers:

### 38.6.0 NFHS RULE EXCEPTION

#### 38.6.1 Tie-breakers

- A. Tie-breakers may be used if approved by the league or the teams involved.
- B. The following procedures will be utilized for all soccer playoff contests:
  1. Two (2) sudden death five (5) minute overtimes. If still tied, penalty kicks will decide the results.
  2. Only the 11 players involved in the final minute of the final overtime will be allowed to kick any penalty kicks.

## **POST-GAME**

**Teams will do a traditional post-game handshake line.** Teams will have 10 minutes post-game to exit the field/facility for proper cleaning and stadium sanitizing. At the conclusion of the game please make sure all garbage has been cleaned up, and all items taken with.
