- 6. Honored Passes:**
 - SeaKing District Lifetime Pass, KingCo Lifetime Pass and Metro Lifetime Pass.
 - Metro and KingCo League or Coaches' Passes will not be accepted.
 - 7. Roster & Pass List:**
 - Pass list including team roster, stats/scorebook personnel, team managers, coaches, and supervisors must be given to the gate on Day 1 or sent to Dan Jurdy.
 - 8. Team Uniforms:**
 - Players must wear identical regulation team uniforms with numbers.
 - **Metal cleats are not allowed on the turf at SWAC**
 - 9. Team Entry & Tournament Format:**
 - Team roster is limited to 20 players, 2 team managers, and 1 scorekeeper. Bench is limited to team entry roster (eligible players only) and official coaching staff.
 - See tournament bracket (attached).
 - 10. Locker-Rooms:**
 - Locker-Rooms will not be available for team use; players/teams should arrive in appropriate uniforms, dressed, and ready to play.
 - Restrooms are located near the entrance/ticket sales table.
 - 11. Post-Season Advancement**
 - The top 5 teams from the SeaKing Tournament will advance to the WIAA State Softball Tournament
 - 12. Postponement Procedures:**
 - Schools will be notified as early as possible if games are delayed or postponed
 - Games will be played on the next available day.

13. Games Discontinued:

- Per WIAA: Any game that is interrupted with teams having played less than the required number of innings to be considered a regulation game according to NFHS rules will be continued from the point of suspension.
 - The tournament manager shall determine when the game will be completed.
 - The line-up and batting order of each team shall be exactly the same as the line-up and batting order at the moment of suspension, subject to the rules governing the game.

14. Home Team:

- In games #1-8, the home team is the higher seeded team and will get their choice of dugout.
- In games #9-15, the home team is determined by a coin toss to be held at least 30 min prior to the start of the game. The higher seeded team calls the toss and winner has the option of choosing home and away.
- The team who loses the coin toss will have the option of choosing their dugout.

15. Umpires:

- The tournament management and the Umpires Association will schedule umpires.
- Two (2) umpires will be scheduled per game.

16. Pregame Warm-up & Infield Practice:

- The home team will take infield for TEN (10) minutes followed by the visiting team.
- Teams arriving early may be able to warm-up on the baseball field
- SWAC has 4 cages, each team may have access to 1 cage prior to their game, teams provide their own balls

17. Game Balls:

- Tournament Directors will provide 2-game balls for each game (1-Gameball per team prior to warm-up).
 - These will be the new official state ball, Baden Perfection, 2BSFPY.
- Each team must provide backup game balls (WIAA Approved Balls) for each game.

18. Ground Rules:

- The umpire will review the ground rules with the Head Coaches prior to the start of the game.

19. Game Length:

- All games are played to completion (7 innings) except when games are called due to inclement weather, or undefined circumstances that cause the game to end.
- If either team is ahead by 15 or more runs after 3 innings; or 10 or more runs at the end of 5 innings, the game will end with that team declared the winner.
- EXTRA INNINGS: if necessary, the NFHS tiebreaker rule 4-2-6 will be used.
 - Top of the 9th inning, the lead runner – 9th scheduled batter for that inning – is placed at 2nd base.

20. Official Score:

- The home team will keep the official scorebook.

21. Protests:

- The coaches & umpires must resolve all questions/problems concerning rule interpretations immediately.
- If needed, the umpire may consult the Games Committee who will make the final decision.
