ADMISSION

Games played at higher seeds, no admission.

FUNKO FIELD: (Cash/GoFan available)

\$8 Adults, Students w/o ASB \$6 Students w/ASB, Elementary, Senior Citizen All Students, host and visiting, must pay admission at Funko Field.

GAMES COMMITTEE

If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation of misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident in question, and prior to the resumption of action, that the contest is being played under protest. At that point the official(s) will suspend the contest until a decision of the Games Committee has been determined. The Games Committee will meet immediately. The coach shall be afforded the opportunity to present rationale and justification including the specific rule(s) in question, action taken by the tournament officials, and desired outcome. The Games Committee will deliberate in closed session. The decision of the Games Committee is final.

COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSION

- Superintendents, building administrators, athletic directors and/or supervisory personnel from each school will be admitted when they present a valid NW District 1 or District 2 EVENT Supervisory pass.
- Additional accepted passes: State Coaches & Athletic Directors' Association passes, WOA State Observer passes, NW District 1 and WIAA Lifetime passes.
- Press: Members of the working press and press photographers who are covering the playoffs will be admitted free with appropriate credentials. School Photographers — Participating schools will be permitted to have one newspaper photographer and one yearbook photographer.

ROSTERS/PROGRAM INFORMATION

- Team eligibility will be in accordance with the State guidelines.
- Roster changes may be made between each day of the tournament.
- Rosters and team personnel will be pulled from WPAN 24 hours prior to the first round. 20 PLAYER MAX
- Each school will be allowed a maximum of 29 people on the pass list for admittance into the stadium. This number is to include: managers, bus driver, scorekeeper, faculty representative, coaches and players. This list should be submitted to WPA network site by Wednesday at noon before the first round.

RAINOUT PROCEDURE

If any of the games are rained out on a particular day, all games that day will be postponed and rescheduled to the next available day. In case of a rainout for a 4 pm game, schools will be called by 1:30 pm. If a game is interrupted prior to the 5th inning or after the 5th inning and the score tied after the last complete inning, the game shall be suspended and resumed at the point of interruption on the next available day. The line-up and batting order of each team shall be exactly the same as the line-up and batting order at the moment of suspension, subject to the rules governing the game. If a game is interrupted after the 5th inning and the score is not tied after the last complete inning, the game shall be called official, and the winner declared according to the score at the end of the last complete inning.



OFFICIALS

- Officials for play-in games and games played at the higher seed will be the responsibility of the home school.
- The reservation of tournament umpires (Games 5,6 and Games 9-11) shall be the responsibility of the NW District One Director.

AWARDS POLICY

- A team trophy will be presented to the first-place finisher.
- There will be a short presentation ceremony at the conclusion the championship game.

PROTESTS

Decisions on protests must be determined at the time of the protest. The tournament committee will act on all tournament protests.

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE INFORMATION

- A. The tournament director will collect starting lineups 45 minutes before game time. Teams will exchange lineups at this time.
- B. Dressing facilities will NOT be available. Teams are to come dressed and ready to play.
- C. Towels will NOT be provided.
- D. Each team will be allowed 10 minutes of infield/outfield warm up, starting with the home team.
- E. The home team will be the team with the higher seed.
- F. The home team will use the third base dugout.
- G. Only uniformed players will be allowed on the team bench.
- H. Game length / 10 run rule: All games are seven (7) innings and must be played to completion, except if one team is ahead by ten (10) runs or more after the completion of five (5) innings. In this case the game will be over. Any game ending in a tie after seven (7) innings will continue until a winner is determined. In case of a game being called after it has begun due to inclement weather, five (5) innings will constitute a regulation game. If the game is suspended due to inclement weather prior to being a regulation game, the game will resume from the point of suspension per WIAA State Tournament Guidelines.
- I. Game balls will be the host schools' responsibility. Game balls will be provided at Funko Field
- J. The host site will provide the official scorekeeper. The tournament director will provide the score keeper for Funko Field.
- K. The WIAA Baseball State Guidelines will be followed.

COUNTDOWN TO GAME TIME

- 30 Minutes before game time- Home Team 10 minute warm up
- 20 Minutes before game time- Visiting Team 10 minute warm up
- 7 Minutes before game time- Home plate meeting
- 5 Minutes before game time- Introductions

INTRODUCTIONS

- 1.Both teams will go to their respective dugouts.
- 2. Home team will line up between home plate and third base facing the stands.
- Visiting team will line up between home plate and first base facing the stands.
- 4.Reserves will be introduced first followed by the startersand coaches.
- 5. National Anthem following the introductions (for first game only).

PARKING/ENTRANCE/TICKET SALES

Funko - All parking, ticket sales and entrance to the stadium will be at the SOUTH END ONLY (39th and Broadway).

Buses should drop student/athletes off at the SOUTH gate and park in the back of the parking lot
