A Sea-King seeding committee made up of KingCo, Metro, and Sultan AD's will seed the tournament. Only locked seeds are KingCo #1 as the 1 seed and Metro #1 as the 2 seed. The remaining 7 seeds will be determined by the committee.

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Passes

District 2 Tournament Matches - WIAA, District 2 Lifetime passes are the only passes that will be honored. Specifically, League Faculty and District passes **will not** be honored.

Sportsmanship/Spirit: Signs, Flags, Noisemakers, Bands

Each school will be afforded one official school banner. That banner may be in the form of a flag or a sign promoting the school. *Noisemakers* will not be allowed in the stadium. School Supervisors will have authority to confiscate any noisemakers. Security will escort any fan unwilling to give up noisemaker(s) outside of the stadium and that fan will not be allowed to return to the stadium.

Post Season Playoff Supervision

Each school participating in a post season team sport tournament must have an administrator or designee present at all contests involving their school. It is incumbent on each school to deem which individual sport(s) will need an administrator or designee for supervision. It is not the job of the Tournament Director to address fan behavior during these contests. When problems arise, it is expected that the two school administrators will work together in a timely way to share information and problem solve solutions. It is the school's responsibility to keep fans off the playing field/floor at all times, particularly at the conclusion of the games. The home-site administrator shall provide a suitable site and supervision for an ejected player or coach.

Band Guidelines

- a. Home school bands may perform at all home events. This restriction applies to bands of all forms: full band, pep band, or combos. An adult Director/Advisor **MUST** be present.
- b. Bands may perform only at time outs, and at quarters or half times.
- c. Individually organized bands or groups are not permitted to perform at any athletic event.
- d. The visiting school band may perform by mutual consent. When granted, the order of performance should follow the playoff game format.

Medical and Athletic Training

The host school will provide a Certified Athletic Trainer present for site medical services. Taping can be done by the ATC, but each school will need to provide its own supplies. Ice and water will be available on the field to all participants.

Rosters:

Limit is 22 players for League, District and State Tournaments

- 6 designated team/school personnel (coaches, managers, and statisticians)
- 1 medical professional
- Rosters may be changed in between EACH CONTEST
- **Please have updated roster on WPA by 12:00pm of the day of contests**
- Host sites will be responsible for printing rosters

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Default Game Times

Default time for week day games is 7:00pm

Default time for Saturday games is 2:00pm

These can be adjusted based on facilities, other needs, and if both teams agree.

Overtime Procedures

Will follow the same OT format that the State uses in their tournament.

- 1) If the game is tied at the end of regulation they will play 2 x 5-minute sudden victory periods.
- 2) If the game is tied at the end of overtime periods they will go to 5 penalty kicks.
- 3) If the game is tied at the end of 5 penalty kicks then sudden death victory penalty kicks.
