#### **Tournament Policies and Regulations**

The tournament shall be governed by the WIAA rules and regulations, Northwest District One policy, and NFHS rules. Each site will appoint a Tournament Committee which will be empowered to make decisions or judgments deemed necessary that are not specifically addressed in these instructions. Any item for consideration by the Committee must be submitted to the Tournament Manager or the local Site Managers.

#### **General Information:**

The purpose of the Northwest District One 2A Volleyball Tournament is to seed District One teams into the state Volleyball championships. Two teams will advance to the state championships.

Nine teams qualify to participate in the District Tournament, two (2) from the Cascade Conference, and Eight (7) from the Northwest Conference.

District Tournament play is divided into four days and the format will be a double elimination bracket after the day one play-in matches. Play-in, first round and matches will be played at higher seeds. All other matches will be played at **Meridian High School**.

**The winner of match 11 will play a cross-over match with the District 5 qualifier for the final spot in the state tournament.**

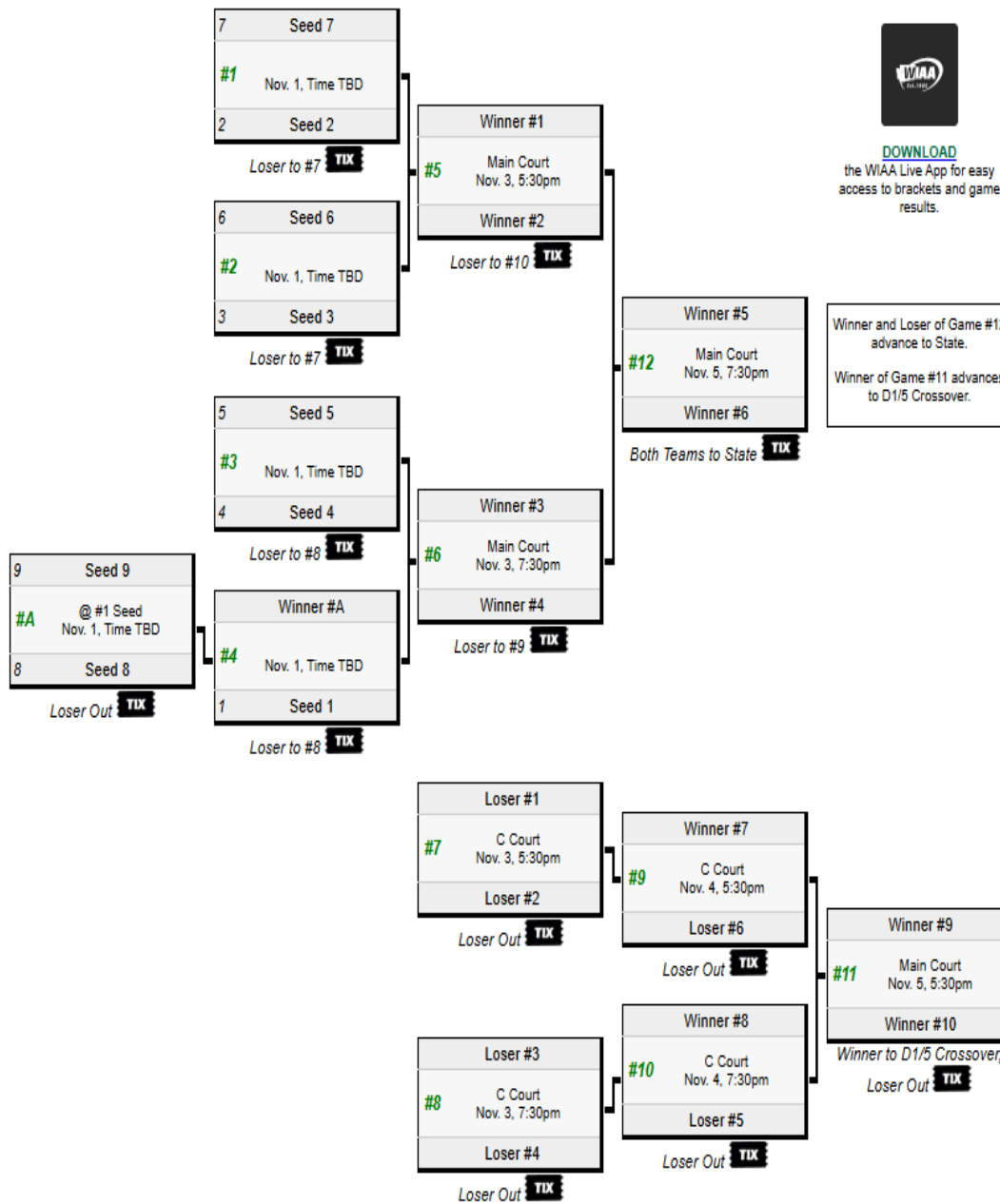

Ticket Prices:

Adults, Students w/out ASB.....	\$9.00

**Tickets may be purchased prior to matches on GoFan.**

Passes:

District One **Event** Supervisors Pass and Lifetime passes will be the only ones accepted for admission. People using the Event Supervisor pass are expected to take an active role in their crowd management.

**\*Regular District One Supervisory Passes are NOT valid for post-season admission.**

**Eligibility:**

- The school must be a member of the WIAA and enrolled in volleyball for the current year
- A participating student must meet all eligibility requirements set by the WIAA
- All players must be certified by the principal at the first state-qualifying tournament
- Official uniforms must be worn for all contests

**General Guidelines:**

- The tournament director will furnish scorekeepers and lines people at all sites
- No signs may be posted with the exception of the school banner, which must be approved by the tournament director.
- Noisemakers are not allowed
- The bench area is restricted to the teams, coach, and managers.
- Teams may not provide their own warm up music.
- Concessions will be available throughout the tournament.
- The tournament director is empowered to make any decisions or judgments deemed necessary, that are not specifically covered by this bulletin

**Gymnasium:**

- The gymnasium will open one hour prior to the start of first match of the day.

**Home Team:**

- The home team is the higher seed, if no higher seed, then the bottom team in the bracket is the home team.

**Locker Rooms:**

- Locker rooms will be available for each participating team. Please check in with the tournament director or event manager upon arrival.
- Security of all valuables is the responsibility of the participating school.

**Warm-Ups:**

- 20 Minutes provided for your first game of the day: 8 minutes shared, 6 minutes home team, 6 minutes visiting team. Warm-ups will start 30 minutes prior to the start of the first game of the day.

**Match Schedule:**

- It is the coaches' responsibility to see that their team is near their assigned playing court at least 15 minutes prior to their match time

**Pre-Game Ceremony:**

- Welcome – WIAA sportsmanship announcement.
- The Pledge of Allegiance / National Anthem will take place prior to the first contest of the day.
- Introductions will take place before each contest.

**Officials:**

- The NW District Board will assign all officials for the District Tournament from the following associations: S.C.B.V.O and the N.W.B.V.O

**Rosters:**

- Each team may have a roster of 14 players. Post-season rosters must be uploaded to the WPA Roster Center by Wednesday, October 29th. **IN ADDITION**, you must fill out the pass list **on the document at the end of this bulletin** and return it to Patrick Brown by Wednesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>. The roster and pass list will be used at the ticket booth as your school's pass list. Both must be done by 8:00am on Wednesday, October 29<sup>th</sup>.

- There will be no roster changes after this deadline (as per WIAA Rule 25.3)

**Tournament Ball:**

- Baden volleyball will be provided for game balls. Each school is responsible for their own warm up volleyballs.

**Ground Rules:**

- Ground rules will be explained at each site by the tournament manager or head official.

**Tournament/Games Committee:**

- The tournament committee shall consist of the tournament director, the head official, a Wesco representative and a Northwest Conference representative.

**Trainer:**

- There will be a trainer available for all matches.

**Filming**

- Filming is allowed from the bleachers only – NOT ON THE MAIN FLOOR.  
Bring your own accessories.

**Trophies:**

- A First-place trophy will be awarded to the District Champion.

**State Tournament:**

- Top 2 teams will advance to the state championships at the Yakima Valley SunDome. There will be a crossover match to determine the 3<sup>rd</sup> team to state. See bracket and description above.
