Teams advance to the tournament via league standings (5 South, 4 North, 3 NWC). Tournament seeded by District 1 Seeding Committee. Winner and Loser of Match #11 and Winners of Match #9 and #10 advance to [State](#). WIAA Seeding Committee will seed the State Tournament Bracket.

## **GAMES COMMITTEE**

A games committee must be in place at all sites, including higher seeded games. The host Athletic Director is responsible for organizing the games committee.

### **Protest Process:**

- If a Head Coach believes there has been a misinterpretation/misapplication of a specific rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident and prior to the resumption of action that the contest is under protest.
- The official(s) will suspend the contest until a decision of the Games Committee has been determined. The Games Committee will meet immediately or as soon as is reasonably possible upon receiving notification of the protest.
  - During the Games Committee meeting, the coach shall be afforded the opportunity to present rationale and justification including the specific rule(s) in question, how the officials misapplied/misinterpreted the rule(s), and the desired outcome of the protest.
  - The official(s) shall be afforded the opportunity to present the rule and its implementation in the protested situation.
- The Games Committee will consult with the WIAA staff member who oversees that sport; will follow any additional protest procedures covered in the specific NFHS rule book; and will utilize the NFHS and/or WIAA playing rules, scorebook, and/or statistics to determine the appropriate ruling.
- The Games Committee will deliberate in a closed session.
- The decision of the Games Committee is final and cannot be further appealed.
- Protests of an official's judgment will not be heard

## **ADMISSION**

Doors will open one hour before the first match; spectators use the Athletic Entrance on the North side of Stanwood HS. Tickets may be purchased with cash at the door or online with GoFan: <https://gofan.co/app/school/WA86277>

- Participating teams in the playoff will be admitted by roster. Only players, coaches and managers directly involved in the game are to be included on the roster. Rosters must be uploaded onto the WPA website by Thursday, November 6th. Rosters are limited to 14 players, 6 team personnel and 1 athletic trainer. Your roster will serve as your pass list.
- Superintendents, building administrators, athletic directors and/or supervisory personnel from each school will be admitted when they present a valid NW District One Event Supervisory pass.
- Additional accepted passes: State Coaches & Athletic Directors' Association passes, WSSAAA Member Pass, WOA Observation Pass and NW District One and WIAA Lifetime passes.

### **LOCKER ROOMS**

Locker rooms will be available for each participating team. On Thursday, there will be 2 teams assigned to 1 locker room (5pm/7pm match). Please check-in with the tournament director upon arrival. Security of all valuables is the responsibility of the participating school; do not leave valuables in the locker room.

### **WARM-UP**

Official warm ups for each match will be 20 minutes and follow the 8-6-6 format:

8 minutes of shared time, 6 minutes visiting team, 6 minutes home team.

Hitting or serving the ball into the opponent's court is not allowed during the shared court time.

Matches happening simultaneously will use a shared warm up clock once both courts are available.

Teams are not allowed to warm up on the sidelines or the endlines while waiting for their court time.

Equal access to warm up space (aux gym, etc) must be provided to all teams waiting for the official 20 minute pregame warmup time.

\*At Stanwood HS, teams may use the auxiliary gyms to warm up, but ball handling is only allowed in the main gym.

### **OFFICIALS / EVENT STAFF**

Officials (head referee, down referee and lines people) will be assigned by the host school's local officials association.

The host school will provide the site manager, ticket taker / seller, announcer, scorekeeper, libero tracker and scoreboard operator.

## **VOLLEYBALLS**

The home team is responsible for providing 3 game balls. Game balls must meet NFHS guidelines. The ball must be leather (not brushed) and at least one-third of the ball must be white, but not all white.

Host schools are responsible for providing warm up balls.

## **FINANCES**

All financial arrangements will be in accordance with NW District One financial policies for District Tournaments.

## **MEDICAL STAFF**

Stanwood High School's Athletic Trainer will be on site. Each team will be responsible for their own training and medical supplies. Please bring your own med bag.

## **SPECTATOR RESTRICTIONS**

On Thursday, individuals watching matches from the main gym at SHS must be on a team roster. All other spectator seating is in the second level bleachers; there is no standing along the railing/walkway.

## **CONCESSIONS**

Concessions will be available at Stanwood High School.

## **PARKING**

Buses will be asked to park in the bus stalls on the South side of the school. Participating teams can enter through the lower level. All other spectators enter through the athletic entrance on the North side of the building.
