ATHLETIC TRAINER/MEDICAL

Each team will be responsible for their own training and medical needs. There will not be an Athletic Trainer provided for the tournament.

OFFICIALS

Officials (head referee, down referee and lines people) will be assigned by the host school's local officials association.

AWARDS

- i. A team trophy will be presented to the first-place team.
- ii. A short presentation of the trophy will take place at the conclusion of the championship match.

DATES/TIMES

Refer to bracket for game times/ locations. Opening Rounds Saturday 11/8 game times are 12pm and 2pm. Tuesday and Thursday game time is 7pm. Saturday 11/15 game times are 10am and 12pm. Please defer to the bracket for game times. Game times at higher seeds may be adjusted by mutual consent of the two teams.

GAMES COMMITTEE

- i. Each host site will have a Games Committee that will consist of the site manager, the head official, and a coach, athletic director or school administrator not involved in the dispute in question. Games committee members do not need to be onsite but must be readily available via phone during the scheduled game(s).
- ii. If a coach feels there has been a misinterpretation or misapplication of a rule, the coach shall notify the game officials following the incident in question that they'd like to protest.
- iii. At that time the official(s) will suspend the protested contest until a decision of the Games Committee has been determined. The Games Committee will meet immediately. The coach shall be afforded the opportunity to present rationale and justification including the specific rule(s) in question, action taken by the tournament officials, and desired outcome. The Games Committee will deliberate in closed session. The decision of the Games Committee is final. The game cannot resume until the protest has been ruled on by the games committee.

PRE-MATCH WARM-UPS

Warm-ups for each match will be 20 minutes and follow the 8-6-6 format. 8 minutes of shared time, 6 minutes visiting team, 6 minutes home team. Hitting or serving the ball into the opponent's court is not allowed during the shared court time.

- ii. Teams are not allowed to warm-up on the sidelines or the end lines while waiting for their court time.
- iii. Equal access to warmup space (aux gym, etc.) must be provided to all teams waiting for the official 20 minute pregame warm up time.

TEAM INTRODUCTIONS

- i. Teams will line up in front of their respective bench.
- ii. Non-starters (visiting team first) will be introduced, take a step forward and remain standing.
- iii. Starters (visiting team first) will be introduced and will proceed to their respective end line after their name is read.
- iv. The announcer will lead the pledge of allegiance after teams are introduced.

ALLOCATIONS TO STATE

The top 5 teams from the tournament will advance to the 4A state championships to be held at the Yakima Valley SunDome on Nov. 21-22.

PASS LIST

- Participating teams will be admitted by roster. Maximum of 21 team personnel on the WPA Roster. 14 Players, 6 team personnel and 1 athletic trainer directly involved in the game are to be included on the roster. Rosters must be uploaded onto the WPA website BY Friday Nov 7 at noon. Your roster will serve as your pass list
- Superintendents, building administrators, athletic directors and/or supervisory personnel from each school will be admitted when they present a valid NW District 1 or District 2 EVENT Supervisory pass.
- Additional accepted passes: State Coaches & Athletic Directors' Association passes,
 WOA State Observer passes, NW District 1 and WIAA Lifetime passes.
- Cheerleaders of participating schools will be admitted free if in uniform.
- Press: Members of the working press and press photographers who are covering the
 playoffs will be admitted free with appropriate credentials. School Photographers —
 Participating schools will be permitted to have one newspaper photographer and one
 yearbook photographer on the floor.

EVENT STAFFING/TABLE HELP

The host site will provide the site manager, ticket taker/sellers, announcer, scorekeeper, libero tracker and scoreboard operator.

FINANCES

Host schools will submit financial reports to their respective District in a timely manner.

TOURNAMENT PROCEDURE INFORMATION

- Teams will NOT be switching sides between games.
- The host school will be responsible for furnishing 3 NFHS approved game balls.
- Each team will provide their own volleyballs for warm-ups at the championship site.
- No artificial noise makers or signs (official school banners are allowed) in the gyms.
- Gyms will open a minimum of 1 hour before the scheduled first match.
- Team Benches are restricted to official team personnel as listed on the team roster.
- School supervisors of participating schools should check in with the site manager. School supervisors are responsible in helping maintain good sportsmanship and behavior of their fans.
- For the championship site: NO Locker rooms will be available for team use.
