NO EXCEPTIONS. No one other than those listed on the official roster will be allowed on the playing floor or team bench, except team medical personnel. All players/coaches and managers must enter together through the main gym entrance.

Administrator Supervision

Each school should have an administrator or designee on site to supervise and assist with crowd control. Please contact Erika Reddick with the name of the supervisor prior to game day. That school supervisor should check in with Ed Call upon arrival each day.

Officials

The officiating organization will provide all officials to include game officials, line judges, libero trackers and scorers. NMHS will be staffing each scorer's bench with one adult and two student athletes to run the scoreboard and table for each match. Please regard them as members of the officiating team and extend the same level of respect and sportsmanship to each of them. Without these individuals, we would not have a tournament.

Seeding Committee, West Central District, Washington State Coaches Association (WSCA) and Washington Secondary School Athletic Administrator passes will be honored at the pass gate.

Students may not leave and re-enter the gym during the event.

No outside food or drink

Signs and School Banners

No signs other than the official school banners will be allowed in the gyms.

Filming

There are a limited number of electrical outlets available around the bleachers. Please bring plenty of battery power. No extension cords will be run across walkways. Each team may have one videographer. Check with officials for an approved location.

Team Spaces and Locker Rooms

Locker rooms will be available 45 minutes prior to the contest. Locker rooms will be open for general use for changing, not for team meetings. Please respect this shared space and keep all of your personal belongings with you and your team courtside or in the bleacher areas

Officials/Game Staff - Room Available

A room will be available to officials and game staff & coaches.

Cheerleaders

Admitted only in uniform and must remain in the designated area. No more than 8 cheerleaders will be admitted in uniform and they will need to cheer from the spectator stands.

Game Ball

Game balls will be provided by the WCD#3 staff.

Team Benches

The team benches will be designated by the site managers. Neither court side offers an unfair advantage so it is expected that the bench areas will not change throughout the match. Should coaches mutually decide to change benches each game, that must be agreed upon by both head coaches and the R1 for the match.

Pre- Match Warm-up

The coin flip, 8 shared, 6-6 warm-up (serving included) procedure will be followed. The visiting team (lower seed) warms up first. There will be a twenty minute minimum time period between the end of the last match and the start of the warm-up period when teams are playing consecutive matches.

Sportsmanship:

Sportsmanship pins will be awarded at the conclusion of each match to a player, fan, student or whomever from each team, who shows positive sportsmanship.

- The official school banner will be the only sign permitted.
- ALL noisemakers are prohibited and may be confiscated by tournament supervisors.
- The throwing of confetti or other materials is not allowed.
- Derogatory and targeted comments will not be tolerated.
- All players, coaches and fans are expected to honor the game by being positive and encouraging.

Tournament Rules:

2025 National Federation rules will be used with these exceptions:

- Each match will consist of 3 out of 5 games. First four games to 25 and fifth game to 15 with no cap.
- Each school will furnish their own warm-up balls.

Designation of Home Team

The home team will be the bottom team of each bracket and will warm up second.

Player Introductions

Introductions will only be made prior to the start of the championship match. After the introduction, both teams should remain in line and turn to face the flag for the playing of the National Anthem or reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon completion teams should return to their respective benches.

Games Committee

Each Tournament Director shall appoint and name a Games Committee for all postseason contests. Duties of the Games Committee shall be as follows:

- Assist the Tournament Director as needed and be immediately available to him/her during the event.
- Act as an arbitration board of dispute on questions or protests that might arise. The final decision will be the consensus of the Games Committee.
- Questions concerning infractions may be brought to the Games Committee by a coach or person in charge of a team, not by a contestant.
- The Games Committee shall be composed of no fewer than three and not more than five members.
- The Games Committee members may not be involved with the game under dispute and should be composed of:
