IV. ALLOCATIONS (8 to WesKing)

- A. KingCo 4A Champion will be crowned
- B. 8 teams will be seeded into the bi-district WesKing Tournament

V. TICKET INFORMATION AND PASSES

- A. Tickets will be sold via GoFan.com only; cash will not be accepted. Gates will open one hour prior to the first scheduled game.
- B. Prices will be as follows:
 - \$9.00 – Adults/Students without ASB Card
 - \$5.00 – Students with ASB Card, Students K-8
 - NC – Children 5 and under, Senior Citizens
- C. The following will be accepted: SeaKing District Lifetime Pass, KingCo Scouting, KingCo Lifetime, KingCo Supervisor's Pass, WSSAAA passes

VI. ROSTERS/PROGRAM INFORMATION

- A. Team eligibility will be in accordance with the State guidelines (**20 player maximum**)
- B. Rosters will be pulled from WPA Roster Center on Tuesday at noon, prior to the first round. Roster changes may be made between each day of the tournament.
- C. Each school will be allowed a **MAXIMUM OF 29 people** on the pass list for admittance into the stadium. **This number is to include:** managers, bus driver, scorekeeper, faculty representative, coaches and players. **This list should be submitted to WPA network site by Tuesday at noon before the first round.**

VII. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- A. Game length / 10 run rule: All games are seven (7) innings and must be played to completion, except if one team is ahead by ten (10) runs or more after the completion of five (5) innings. In this case, the game will be over. Any game ending in a tie after seven (7) innings will continue until the winner is determined. In case of a game being called after it has begun due to inclement weather, teams will have the opportunity to play out the remainder of the game through the end of the 7th inning on the next playable date. If a winner must be declared in order for a team to advance in the tournament, but the game cannot be continued due to inclement weather, jeopardizing the tournament finishing according to schedule, the results at the end of the last completed inning would be considered the final game score.
- B. In case of postponement, games will be played on the next playable date. If a game is postponed because of weather, **ALL** games will be postponed on that day.
- C. Teams will dress at home.
- D. The higher seeded team is the home team and will have their choice of dugouts.
- E. The higher seeded team will keep the official book. This can be a paper book or Gamechanger.
- F. Each team will be allowed 10 minutes of infield/outfield prior to each game (weather permitting). Home team infield/outfield will begin 25 minutes prior to game time. Visitors infield/ outfield will follow.
- G. Field / Cages are available at host sites. Please communicate arrival time with the Tournament Director, Host AD, and Host Coach.
- H. Rosters are limited to 20 players.
- I. Game balls will be provided by the tournament manager at site

VIII. PROTESTS

Decisions on protest must be determined at the time of the protest. The tournament committee will act on all tournament protests.
