V. RAINOUT PROCEDURES

A. **Wednesday, May 6th @ Home Field of Higher Seeds**

Game #A must be completed by Wednesday Night, May 6th, 2026. If home team field is unplayable on Tuesday May 5th it will be their responsibility to find a turf field and play the game on Wednesday May 6th. If any of these games are not played by Wednesday Night, May 6th the **higher seed** will automatically advance to Thursday May 7th games.

In case of rainout, teams will be notified as soon as possible, usually by at least two hours prior to game time. The schedule below will be followed as closely as possible, but some adjustments may be necessary due to field/umpire availability.

Any game that is interrupted with teams having played less than the required number of innings will be continued from the point of suspension. The Tournament Director shall determine when the game will be completed. The line-up and batting order of each team shall be exactly the same as the line-up and batting order at the moment of suspension, subject to the rules governing the game. (Consistent with WIAA State Tournament Guidelines).

Efforts will be made not to play three days in a row, but cannot be guaranteed. If games are canceled and rescheduling is not covered in this bulletin, the situation will be resolved by the tournament committee.

- B.** If all games #1 - #4 are not completed by **Friday, May 8th** then the tournament will be modified to a 4 team tournament with the original #1-4 seeds participating. First round of games will be played on **Saturday May 9th as shown below:**

- C.** If no games have been played by **Friday May 15th**, the District 1 Director will apply for a tournament extension through the WIAA and determination of these games will be announced at that time.

VI. OFFICIALS / UMPIRES

- A. The reservation & payment of tournament umpires shall be the responsibility of the NW District One Director.

VII. TICKET INFORMATION

- A. Tickets will be sold at the gate. Gates will open one hour prior to the first scheduled game.
- B. Prices will be as follows:

VIII. PASSES/ROSTERS/PROGRAM INFORMATION

- A. Acceptable Passes: **WSCA passes, WSSAAA passes, NW District Event Supervisor's Pass, as well as the WIAA and NW District Lifetime pass will be honored.**
- B. Roster/dugout limit; **each school will be allowed a MAXIMUM OF 29 people on the pass list for admittance into the stadium as noted below**

Schedule, scores, roster and photo must be entered on the school's WIAA account.

All team/school personnel for the pass gate must be entered into the school's MyWIAA account.

- 20 players
- 5 designated school personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, etc)
- 1 bat boy/girl (recommended seventh grade or older)
- 1 medical (must be a licensed health care provider)
- 2 supervisors

Please submit roster/pass list via email to Kirsty Croghan @ kcroghan@asd103.org by May 4th @ 3:00 pm. Failure of non-submittal will result in your school being excluded from the program. Any last-minute changes can be emailed to kcroghan@asd103.org or phoned in to the Anacortes Athletic Office (360-503-1308), no later than 3 PM, Tuesday, May 5th. No changes will be permitted after the first game.

Team eligibility will be in accordance with the WIAA State guidelines.

Once the district tournament begins, team rosters may not be changed until the district tournament is completed (WIAA rule 22.3.0). In the event of an emergency or catastrophe after the tournament begins, team members may be replaced if approved by the tournament manager, thereby permitting a school to add eligible players to restore the team to the original number for tournament play (WIAA rule 22.3.1). The emergency or catastrophe must have an impact on a significant number of eligible team members, not just one or two individual players.

IX. TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. The tournament director will collect starting lineups 45 minutes before game time. Teams will exchange line-ups at this time.
2. Dressing facilities will NOT be available. Teams are to come dressed and ready to play.
3. Batting Cages: There is an outdoor batting cage on the south-west side of the facility, behind the fastpitch field (as shown on the map). This cage will be available to use without reservation but please limit use to 15 minutes if another team is waiting to use it. There are L-screens at these cages but teams will need to provide their own baseballs and tees.
 - Athletes must wear helmets while practicing inside the batting cages.
4. Warm up: There is a full-sized natural surface baseball field (Volunteer Field) adjacent to Daniels Field that will be available for teams to stretch, warm up, throw, etc. Please do not use this field for live batting practice. Also please share the field if another team shows up to use it.
5. The home team will be the team with the higher seed.
6. The home team will use the third base dugout.
7. Only uniformed players, rostered coaches and authorized staff will be allowed on the team bench or in dugouts.
8. Athletic Trainer will be available on site for emergency care. Pregame care, taping, etc must be performed by each team's athletic training staff. Basic first aid items and AED will be available. Emergency services will be called if needed.
9. Game length / 10 run rule: All games are seven (7) innings and must be played to completion, except if one team is ahead by ten (10) runs or more after the completion of five (5) innings, in this case the game will be over. Any game ending in a tie after seven (7) innings, will continue until a winner is determined. In case of a game being called after it has begun due to inclement weather, five (5) innings will constitute a complete game. If the game is suspended due to inclement weather, the game will resume from the point of suspension per WIAA State Tournament Guidelines.
10. Game balls will be provided. Teams must furnish their own warm-up balls.
11. Tournament committee will provide the official scorekeeper and pitch counter.
12. The 2025-26 WIAA Baseball State Guidelines will be followed.
13. Supervision – Each participating school is to provide (1) administrator/designee for supervision of students and fans. Please have this person identify themselves to the tournament director/supervisor.
14. WIAA tournament rules regarding sportsmanship, signs/banners, noisemakers, etc. will be enforced.
15. Dogs are NOT allowed at any of these facilities.
16. Sunflower Seeds and gum are NOT allowed on Daniels Field.

X. AWARDS

A first place District 1 trophy will be awarded at the conclusion of the tournament.

XI. PROTESTS

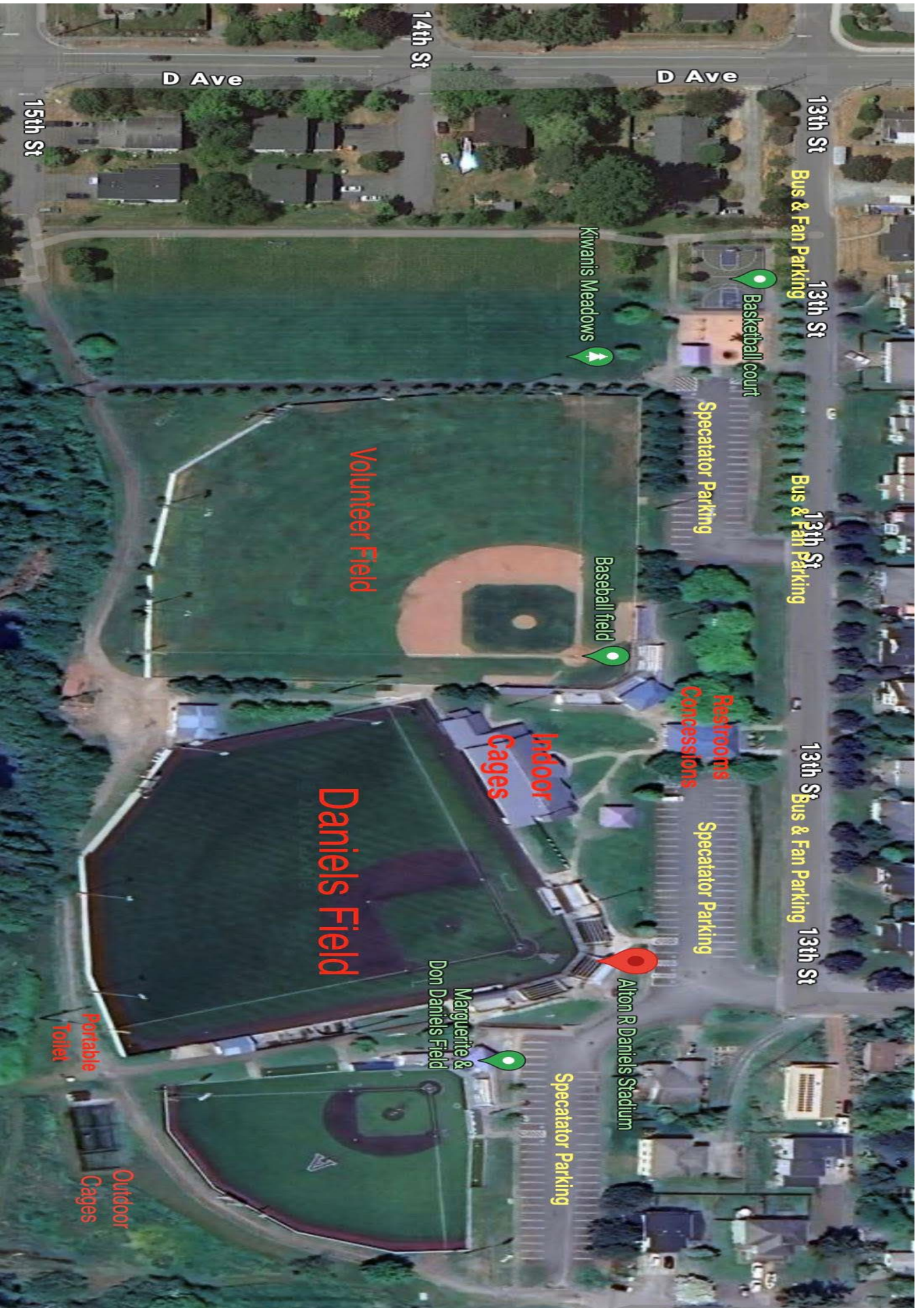
Decisions on protests must be determined at the time of the protest. The tournament committee will act on all tournament protests. Appeals/Protests can only be made if there is a misinterpretation or misapplication of a rule.

XII. PRE-GAME WARM-UP & OPENING CEREMONY

1. Home Team warm-up / infield-outfield will be no more than 10 minutes beginning 30 minutes prior to game time.
2. Visiting Team warm-up / infield-outfield will be no more than 10 minutes beginning 20 minutes prior to game time.
3. Introductions will be 5 minutes prior to game time, as follows:
 - I. Both teams will go to their respective dugouts for introductions
 - II. The starting lineups will be introduced first and will come from the dugout as announced. Then reserve players and coaches will come out
 - III. Visiting team will be announced first, lining up between home plate and first base
 - IV. Home team will be announced last, lining up between home plate and third base
 - V. National Anthem will follow introductions for the first game of each day.

XIII. PARKING, ENTRANCE, TICKET SALES, ETC

- A. Ticket Sales:** Ticket sales will be available at the entrances of both Daniels Fields & the restroom/concession stands building located between each field. Refunds on admission tickets are not provided for postponed or suspended events, or for events that are terminated before their normal conclusion for any reason. Tickets shall be honored for admission to a rescheduled or resumed contest.
- B. Transportation**—AD's please pass along the following information to your transportation department
- a. Games will be played at Alton R Daniels Field, 1309 G Ave, Anacortes, WA 98221
 - b. Directions: From either North or South on I-5
 - i. Take exit I5 & head West on Hwy 20 into Anacortes
 - ii. Turn Right onto Commercial Ave
 - iii. Continue North on Commercial and turn Left on 12th Street
 - iv. Continue West on 12th Street and turn Left on D Ave.
 - v. Short distance on D Ave and turn Left on 13th Street
 - vi. Drop off team but busses cannot park in the lots at baseball fields
- Buses can park along the curb facing East on 13th Street. Please do not park buses in the parking lots.
- C.** All vehicles parked in the lots around the baseball field are at risk of being damaged by a foul ball. The city of Anacortes and Anacortes High School are not liable for any vehicle damage caused by foul balls. Park at your own risk.
